SCHOOL BOARD ATTORNEY

The Hilliard City Board may employ legal counsel in addition to the City Solicitor/City Law Director and pay for legal services from District funds.

The counsel advises the Board and its officials on legal matters relating to them and their powers.

In engaging legal counsel, the Board may require submission of a written proposal which can be incorporated into a contract or purchase order if it satisfies the wishes of the Board. Proposals could detail:

- 1. specific objectives to be accomplished by the counsel;
- 2. a list of specific tasks to be performed;
- 3. procedures to be used in carrying out the tasks;
- 4. target dates for the completion of tasks;
- 5. methods to be used to report results to the Board and/or to deliver any product or render any service to the Board and
- 6. a fee agreement clearly specifying all fees for legal services and termination rights.

The Board will establish procedures necessary to effect an efficient working relationship between the counsel and the Board and/or staff members. Staff must have the Superintendent's/designee's and Treasurer's/designee's approval prior to consulting with Board counsel.
