

## SUMMER SCHOOLS

Summer school programs shall meet all minimum standards as they apply to the specific courses offered.

A student taking new work in a summer school program shall have the minimum number of clock hours of instruction required by Ohio Standards.

A student taking work to make up a failure shall take an amount of work based on the student's needs as determined by the building principal.

The maximum student load shall be one new unit per summer, with a maximum of three such units counting toward graduation.
