

GROUPING FOR INSTRUCTION

The Board believes that children should be grouped for instruction in whatever way that most effective learning will take place.

The decision for any grouping or organization within the building is the responsibility of the principal. At times this may require grouping students in grade or course sections according to achievement, ability or rate of progress.

Within a school, multiple level (combined) classes may be established to meet the individual needs of students and permit their individual growth and continuous progress.

If there is a demonstrated change in a student's achievement, ability or rate of progress, a change in the student's group assignment may be deemed advisable.
