

## ALTERNATIVE STUDENT SCHEDULES

When documentation of a student's special learning needs results in implementation of a program other than, or in addition to, the regular curriculum, the following will occur:

1. The student is responsible for long-range assignments, projects, new concepts and tests in the regular classroom, as specified to the student by the teacher.
2. If the student misses a required test while attending the alternative curriculum program, the classroom teacher will arrange to have the test administered with no grading penalty.
3. The student will not be responsible for seatwork or homework assigned in the regular classroom during the time he/she is scheduled in the alternative program.
4. Alternative Program shall be defined as:

Title I/Reading programs  
Chapter Programming  
Learning Disabilities Tutoring (I.D.E.A.)  
Gifted Services  
Intervention Programming  
ELL Programming

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
