

STUDENT PROGRESS REPORTS TO PARENTS

Student progress reports, on a regularly scheduled basis, shall be sent to the parent or guardian of each student. Such reports shall give the parent or guardian an understanding of a student's progress in each subject. Teachers shall maintain ample written records to substantiate each report given.

Interim reports shall be sent to the parent or guardian of any student encountering academic difficulties at the midpoint of each grading period.
