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HOMEWORK

Homework is an important part of the educational process and is valid if it has the following objectives:

- 1. promotes growth in self-responsibility and self-direction in learning;
- 2. enriches and extends school research experiences;
- 3. brings students in contact with out-of-school learning resources;
- 4. provides essential practice in developing skills.

Homework can be a valuable resource for teaching, allowing students to practice, and in doing so, learn the material. Homework is to be used as a positive learning experience for students, and never as punishment for disciplinary reasons.

Homework assignments are to be made in accordance with the regulations approved by the Board.
