

EARLY GRADUATION

The normal academic load for a high school student should equal between four and one-half and five and one-half units.

Students, under certain conditions, may earn additional units by attending summer school.

Students, under certain conditions, may earn additional units by carrying more than a normal class load. In granting permission for more than a normal load, the building principal concerned shall consider the following:

1. A student's accumulative grade average should be not less than 2.75.
2. Parents should give approval for the increased load.

Students who meet all of the graduation requirements ahead of their normal graduation date shall be considered graduates at the time the requirements are met.
