

STUDENT POLICIES GOALS

The student is the focal point of all operations of a school district.

Consequently, the Board shall spend much of its time in study, deliberation and policy formulation on matters directly related to students.

The Board and staff shall work together to achieve the following goals:

1. to tailor the learning program in order to provide appropriately for each student according to his/her specific background, capabilities, learning styles, interest and aspirations;
2. to protect and observe the legal rights of students;
3. to enhance the self-image of each student by helping him/her feel respected and worthy through a learning environment that provides positive encouragement through frequent success;
4. to provide an environment of reality in which students can learn personal and civic responsibility for their actions through meaningful experiences as school citizens and
5. to promote faithful attendance and good work.
