

STUDENT POLICIES GOALS

The student is the focal point of all operations of a school district.

Consequently, the Board shall spend much of its time in study, deliberation and policy formulation on matters directly related to students.

The Board and staff shall work together to achieve the following goals:

1. to tailor learning opportunities in order to provide appropriately for each student recognizing his/her specific background, capabilities, learning styles, interest and aspirations;
2. to develop each student's potential and support the growth of every student through learning opportunities;
3. to provide a culture of learning environments in which students can learn personal and civic responsibility in a global society;
4. to protect and observe the legal rights of students and
5. to promote faithful attendance and engagement.
