President's Welcome: Kimberly VanGundy called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

Secretary Report: The February meeting minutes were presented and discussed. Melissa Doult made a motion to approve the minutes and Kimberly VanGundy seconded. The motion was passed with no dissents.

Melissa Doult reported PTO has received ticket sale money for 55 plates. Beth advised she has more on the signup that haven't paid; she will contact those people.

Community Rewards: Vanessa Goulding reported she has setup a Raising Caine's Spirit Night on March 15. Following the Figlio event, the Facebook page will be updated with Amazon Smile info and then a campaign to enlist signups for Kroger Community Rewards.

## **New Business**
