The Ohio Department of Health requires all students entering 7th grade to show written proof of a booster dose of			
tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (Tdap).  This shot is intended to be a booster dose for students who completed the initial series of DTaP/DT/Td which was required.			
for entry into Kindergarten. Some students may have already received this vaccine. Please review your student's immuni			
zation records and/or call your physician to determine if your student still needs this booster. A Tdap booster with the past			
<u>5 years is acceptable</u> . Written proof of the booster vaccine includes a Xeroxed copy of your student's immunization record or a signed statement from your health care provider listing the <b>Tdap</b> immunization and date it was administered. Records			
may be dropped off, mailed, or faxed to Heritage Middle School, fax # 614-921-7501.

Students in grades 7-12 may self-administer a nonprescription/over the counter medication at the parent's discretion. The			
student's parent must send a note with the student (or complete a district medication authorization form) stating the name			
of the medication, dose, time it its be taken, date it is to be taken and then signed by the parent. The student may only			
carry a one day supply of medication in the original container on his/her person. No such medication shall be given to an-
