STATE TESTING

AIR State Testing will take place the week of April 2nd each morning. Monday, April 2nd = ELA Part 1, Tuesday, April 3rd = ELA Part 2, Wednesday, April 4th = Math Part 1, Thursday, April 5th = Math Part 2, and Friday, April 6th = 8th grade Science Parts 1 and 2. During testing week, please make sure your student is well rested, and has their iPad with them and that their iPad is fully charged for testing each day.

Also, Mrs. Feeney has been meeting with classes to make sure student's IPads have the correct updates necessary for State testing. Students must have the following on their IPads for testing: AirSecureTest App 4.1 (downloaded from the district's App Portal) and iOS 11.2.6 or higher. Thanks
