## Spring 2010 Brochure

Hilliard Station will once again offer our students an opportunity to participate in an after school extracurricular activity. A variety of courses will be offered at different times. Hilliard Station staff will supervise the activities.

The following are two necessary requirements that parents need to carefully consider before making a decision to register your child:

1. It is imperative that transportation be arranged so that your child can return home safely after each session. If a child is picked up late more than once, the student may be asked to withdraw from the activity. Please note the pick-up locations on the sign-up sheet.

2. It will be necessary for the instructors to work free of disciplinary problems. If any student consistently misbehaves, he or she will be excluded from the remaining activity sessions, and the enrollment fee will be forfeited.

Please note the following registration guidelines:

- **Separate registration forms must be completed for each course or session your child chooses to participate in (There are 3 forms on the last page that can be cut apart).**

- **All checks must be made payable to the instructor listed with each activity. Cash, if in the exact amount for each course, is acceptable.**

- **Activities are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If a course becomes full, no other checks will be accepted. The check or money will be returned.**

- **If a course is canceled due to low enrollment, your check or money will be returned.**

- **Payment must be received with the registration form to guarantee enrollment. Refunds will NOT be made if a student does not attend.**

- **Students will NOT be notified of enrollment. ALL students who have paid should attend their first class period unless informed otherwise. We always attempt to accommodate all registrants.**

- **Please notify instructor of any medical conditions that may arise during the activities.**

- **Please make sure current Health Histories are on file at school.**
