

The Keys to Your Sixth Grader's Success

One of the keys to success for students is consistency. Students that have trouble turning in homework need a routine that remains as constant as possible. This nightly routine will help your child get his/her ducks in row.

1. Check on the homework for the night and make a list of what needs to be completed. You should be able to obtain this from your child's planner or logs, but if these have not been updated, there are other sources. Some teams have their homework on the web and some just have the homework hotline. The following is a listing of each team and the methods they use to let parents and students know the homework for each night and the assignments your child may be missing.

Team T - Hilliard Website / Homework Hotline (2712) / Mrs. Duckworth and Mrs. Nolan will have their information available on Home Access / Every Thursday Planners have missing assignments listed for each student and parents have to sign and return on Monday. Starting Oct. 5th, Team T will have a study table after school until 3:15 PM.

Team I - Hilliard Website / Homework Hotline (2713) / Every Friday planners have missing assignments listed or highlighted; parents sign and return on Monday.

Team G - Hilliard Website / Homework hotline (2715) / Planners are filled out daily – every Thursday planners have missing assignments listed for each student and parents should sign and return them on Monday / Reflection sheets sent out between interims and grade cards and are to be signed and returned.

Team E - Hilliard Website / Homework Hotline (2716) / Home Access Center (check assignment logs and grades online), Schoolnotes.com (go to schoolnotes.com, type in zipcode 43026 and click on Snyder or Team E) / Planners are filled out daily.

Team R - Hilliard Website / Homework Hotline (2717) / Every Thursday planners have missing assignments listed in them for parents to check and sign.

Team S - Hilliard Website / Homework Hotline (2719) / Home Access Center / reflections are sent home at interims and grade card time.

2. Make sure your child has a quiet and well lit area in which to do homework. This area must enable the student to focus with as little distractions as possible.

3. Allow your child time to work out problems on their own before they come to you for help.

4. Check over homework to make sure it is correct and complete.

5. Sign planner. Email teachers with any questions regarding homework.

6. Have your child place their homework in the same location every night for turn in the next day. Use this time to organize the planner each night. Place all materials in the same place every night, so they will not forget them in the morning.

You are the most important people in your child's life. If your child sees us pulling together as a team and we are all on the same page, then they have a much greater chance of success.
