



Tolles Tuesdays

Jan. 13, 20, Feb. 10, 17, Mar. 3, 10, Apr. 7, 14, May 5

Objective: To give prospective students (grades 9-11) the opportunity to set up a half-day or full-day personalized shadowing experience of one or more programs.

By attending a Tolles Tuesday, students will:

- Be partnered with a student(s) in the program(s) they are interested in;
- Have the opportunity to explore what it is like to be a student at Tolles;
- Meet instructors and talk with other students within the program(s);
- Have a hands-on learning experience in the lab(s);
- Have questions answered about becoming a Tolles student.

These are individualized experiences, scheduled by the prospective student and their families/guardians. They are not meant to be large group tours.

Procedures:

1. Prospective students, parents or associate school counselors should schedule a Tolles Tuesday visit after Jan. 1, 2015 with Beth Fogelsong by emailing bfogelsong@tollestechnology.com or calling 614-873-4666, ext. 4295.
2. Prospective students are ultimately responsible for scheduling, taking care of appropriate permission slips and/or parent notes at their respective schools, and providing transport to and from Tolles. Transport can include parent drop-off, parents staying for the visit, the student riding the associate school's regularly scheduled half-and-or full day buses, or driving oneself.
3. All permission slips, emergency medical forms, and transportation plans must be made no later than 48 hours in advance of the tour date. Mrs. Fogelsong will work with the associate schools to confirm this is taken care of. If it is not, the student will be removed from the list.
4. A limit of 20 spots (and no more than three permitted in an individual program at one time) will be available for each Tolles Tuesday experience. A waiting list will be created and will be used if cancellations occur.
5. All visiting students must abide by the rules and regulations of Tolles while visiting our campus, including safety procedures.
