PTO Elected Officer Positions for 2017-2018 School Year

President

The president shall preside at all meetings of the organization; shall porform such duties as may be prescribed in these Bylaws or assigned to him/her by the organization; shall coordinate the work of the officers and committees; and meet with the principal to keep him/her abreast of all organizational activities.

Vice President

The vice president shall act as an aide to the president and serve in his/her absence.

Secretary

The secretary shall record and report on all minutes of the organization and executive committee meetings. The secretary shall, within 5 days after a general meeting, make available copies of the minutes from the meeting, and the minutes shall be posted online.

Treasurer

The treasurer shall:

A. Have custody of all funds of the organization and shall keep a full and accurate account of all receipts and expenditures as stipulated by Chio Revised Code.

B. Present a financial statement at each meeting.

C. The records shall be examined annually by an auditing committee appointed by the president. They shall certify this statement with their signature. This report shall be made to the Executive Committee and is to be kept in the PTO records at the conclusion of the fiscal year. D. All bills must be submitted to the treasurer for reimbursement from the proper funds, using the proper paperwork, i.e. check reimbursement form. All requests must be accompanied by receipt.

E. The treasurer shall reconcile monthly bank statements and present it to the PTO president or principal within 10 days of the most recent bank statement.

F. All currency deposits must be counted by two (2) persons and verified by the treasurer before deposit.

Assistant Treasurer

The assistant treasurer shall act as an aide to the treasurer and serve in his/hor absonce.
