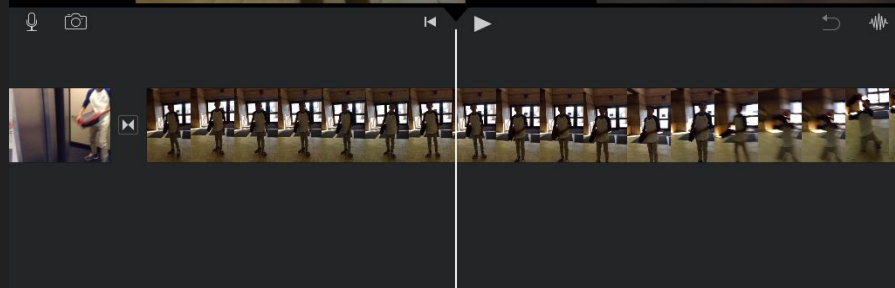
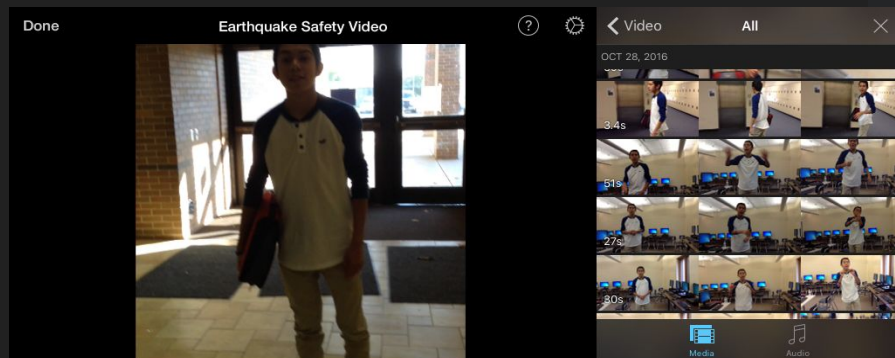
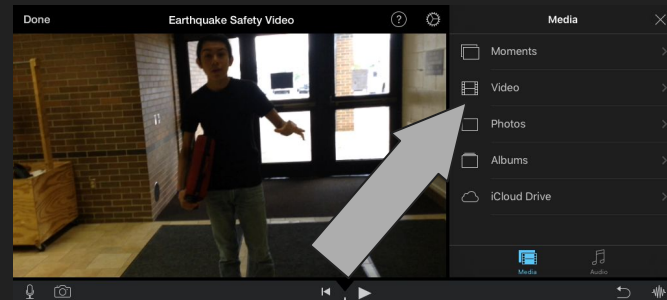


# iMovie editing

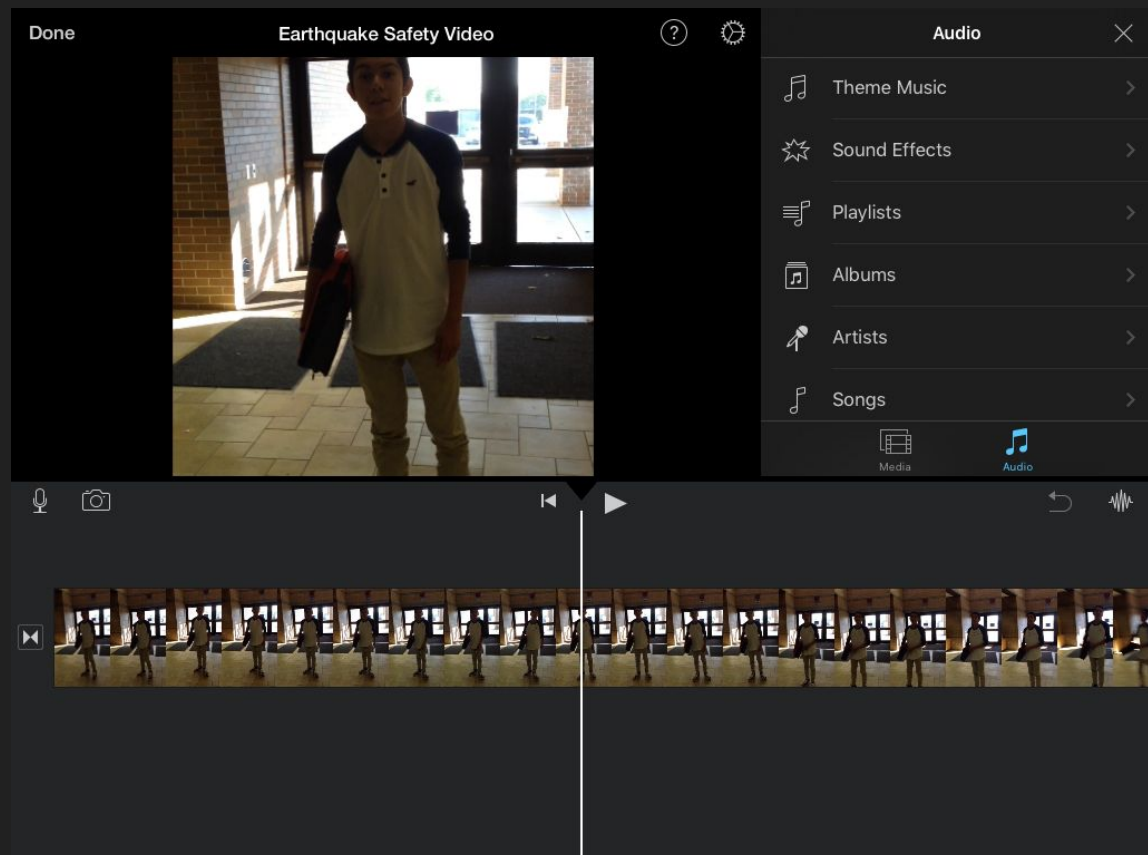
# Adding Videos

To add videos in your iMovie click the + sign in the top right corner and then choose Video. (You can also add Photos from here). Then tap on all videos and choose your videos.



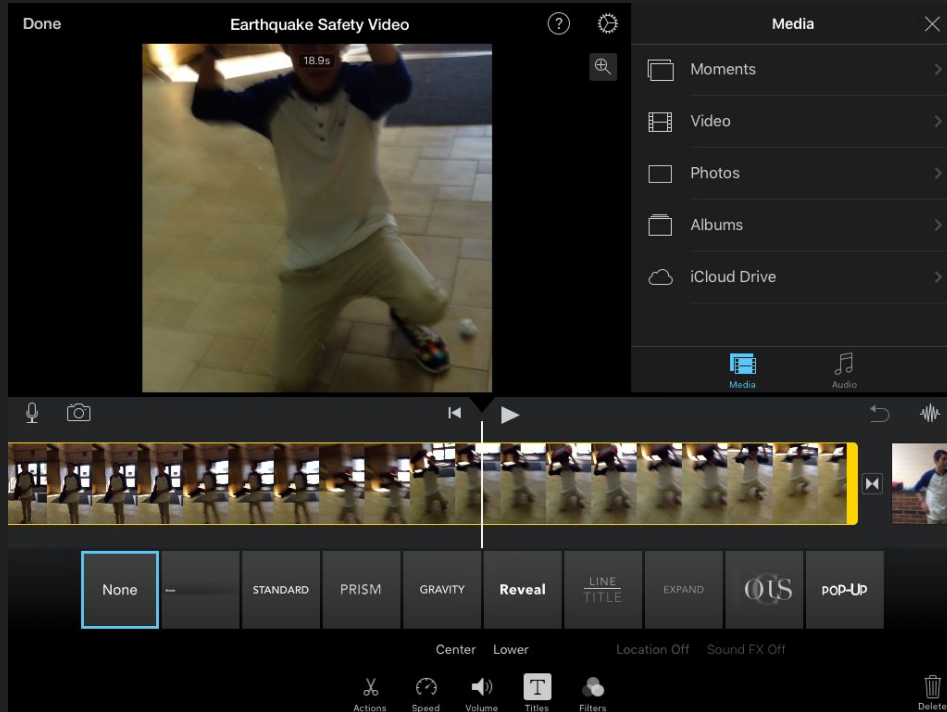
# Adding Sound

To add music or sound effects, you first click on audio and choose either sound effects or theme music.



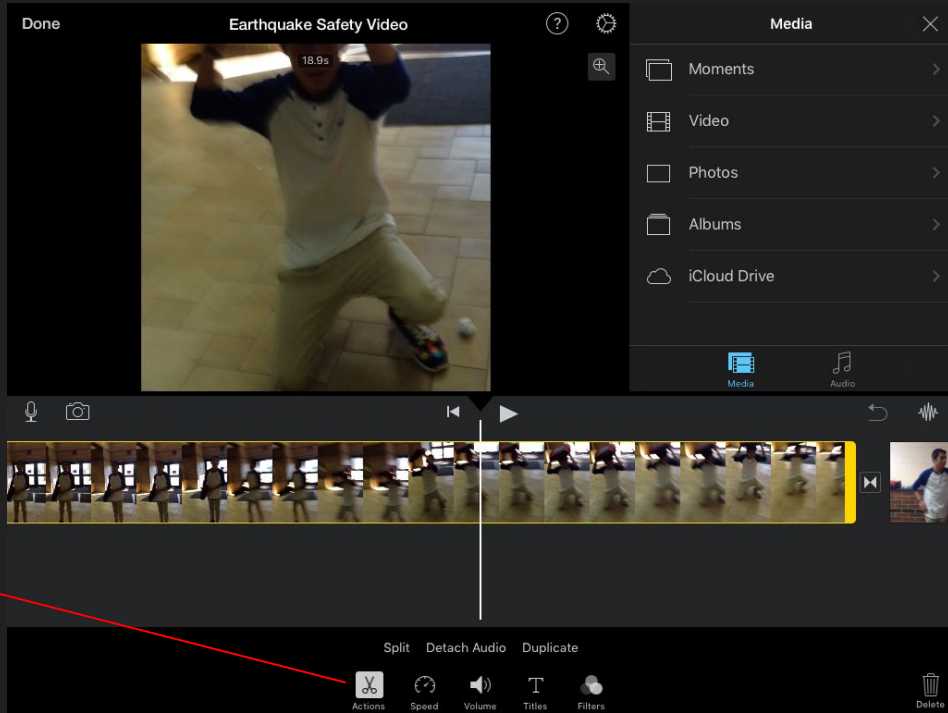
# Adding Text

To add text to a clip in the imovie or title slide, you tap on the video clip that you want to add text to and then tap on titles.



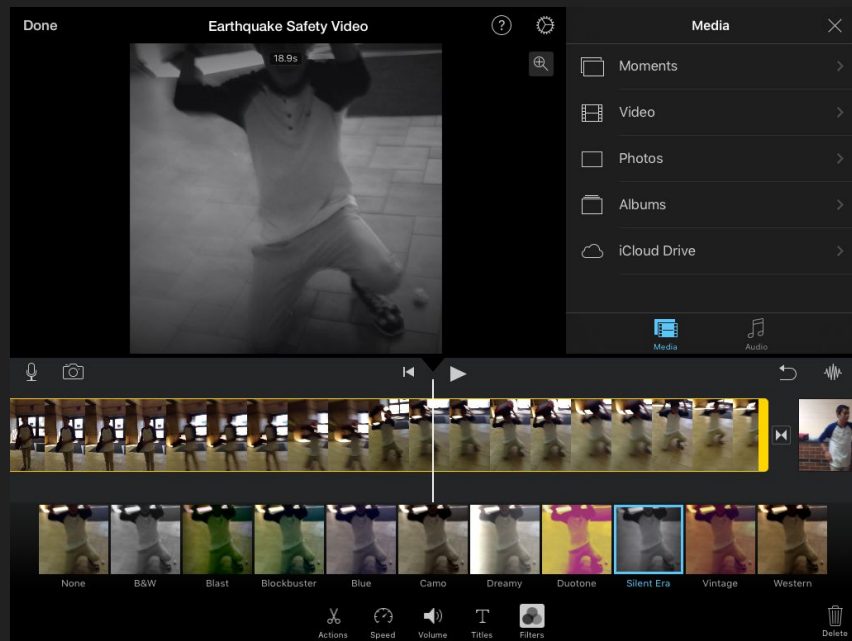
# Actions

When you tap on a video clip, there are various things you can edit. If you tap on actions you can choose to detach the audio, split the clip into 2 clips by moving the white cut line to where you want to split it, or you can also duplicate the video clip.



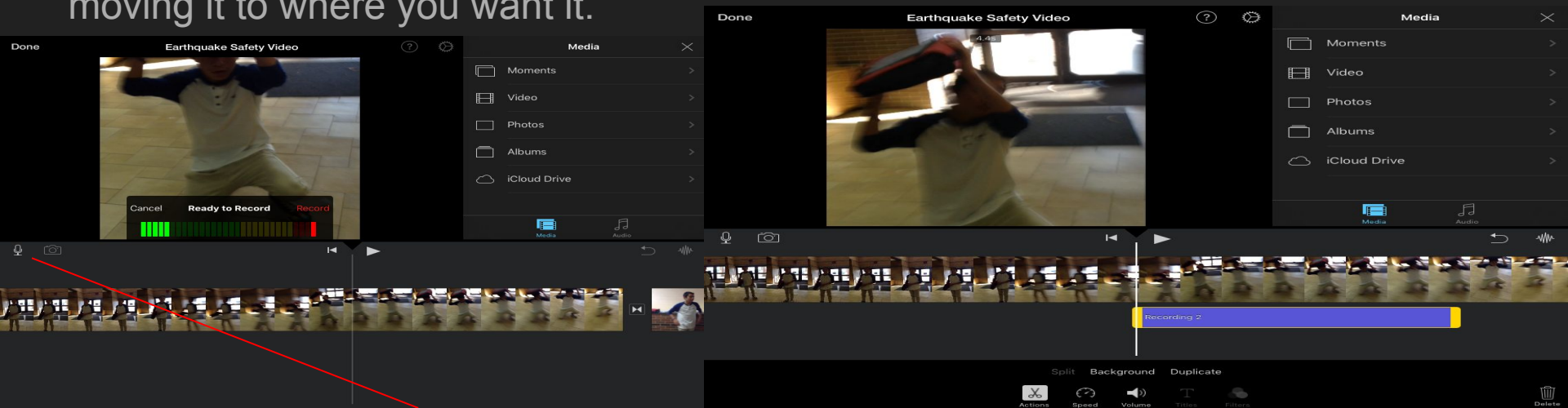
# Other actions

When tapping on a video clip, you have other options to choose from. If you tap on speed, you can only lower the speed of the video but can't make it go faster than what it originally already was. If you tap on volume you can lower the volume or raise the volume of the video clip. You can also tap on filters and change the filter of the video clip.



# Voice over

To add a voiceover, move the white cut line to where you want your voice over to start then tap on the microphone in the center left. After you do this a box will come up showing you the current volume of your voice and you can then just click record. After you are done recording you have the option to review it, retake it, or accept the voice record. After accepting it you have the option to duplicate it or make it a background noise. You can move the voiceover by holding it and then moving it to where you want it.
