



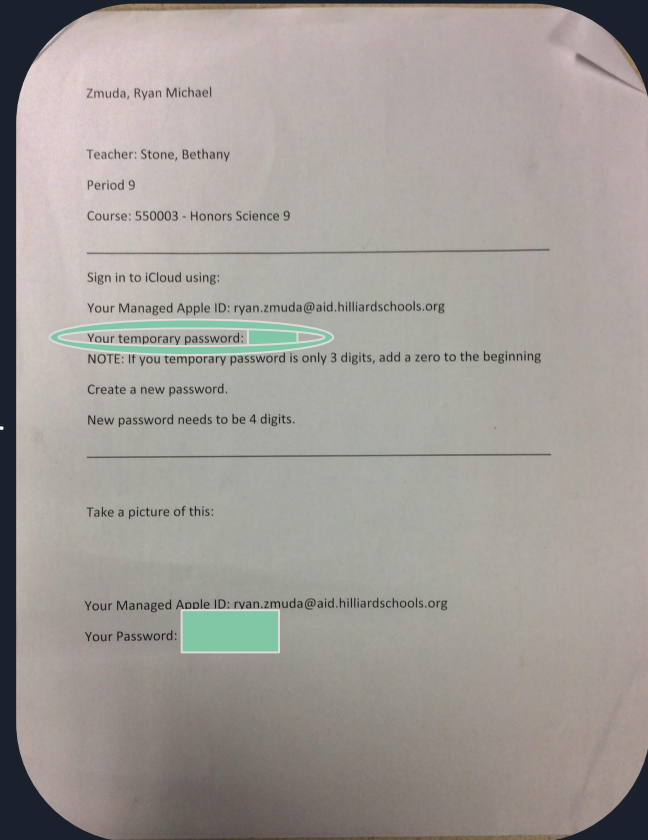
How To Sign Into Your Apple ID

Locating Your Paper

First you need to locate your Apple ID aid log in sheet, given to you by your science teacher. It should look like mine on the right. Looking at your temporary password, if it is only 3 digits you need to put a 0 in front of it. For example, if my password was 123 it would be 0123.



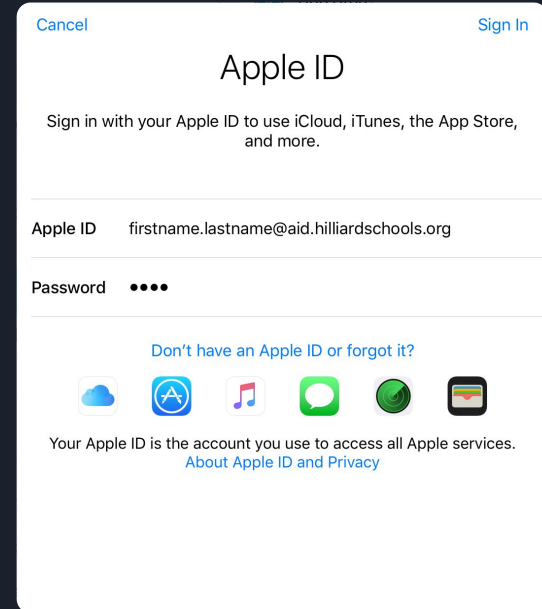
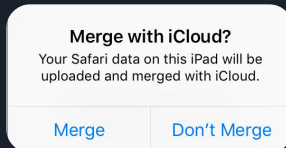
Signing In With Your Temporary Password

You should see a 4 digit temporary password written down on your paper. Navigate your iPad to Settings > Apple ID. You should see a pop up window similar to the one on the right. Type your

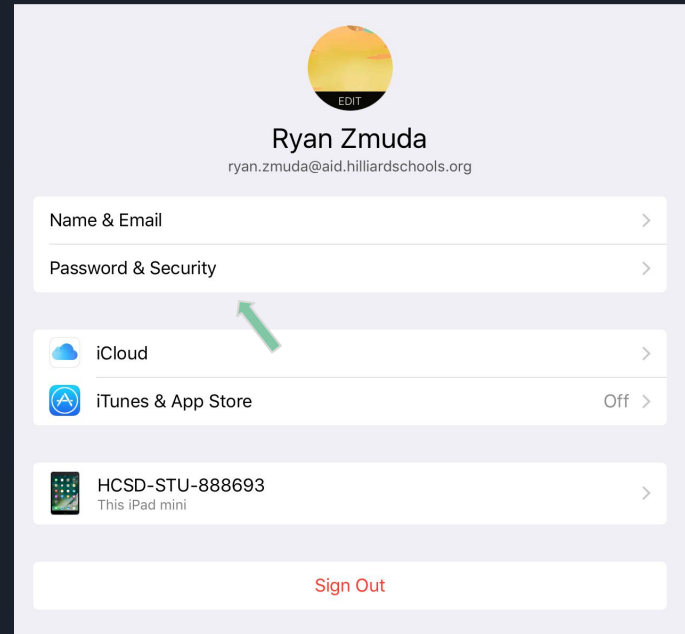
Your password is the temporary password written down on your sheet. Once you type in your information click sign in.

If you receive a pop-up like the one below click merge.



Changing Your Password

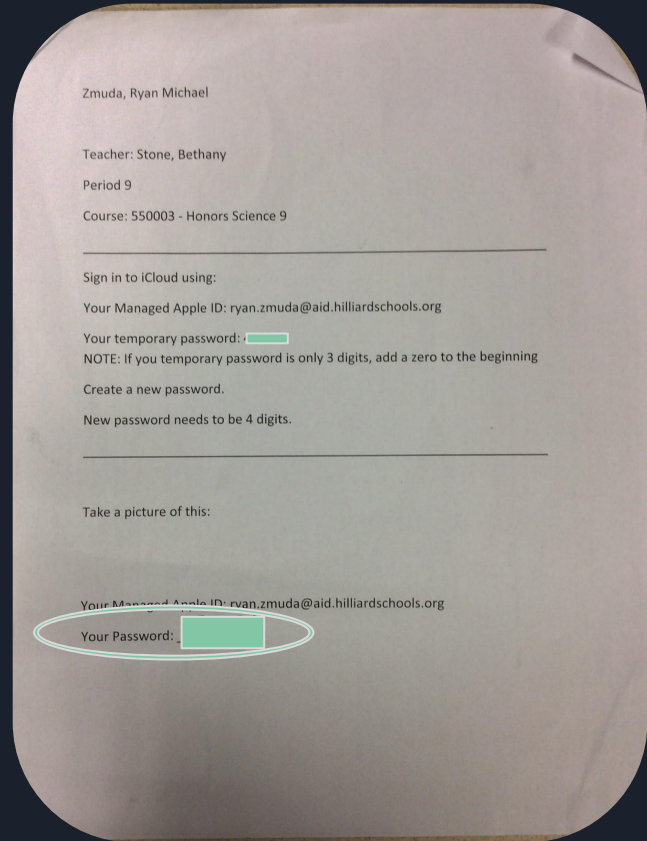
Once you have signed into your Apple ID you need to change your password. If you receive a prompt to change it, click on that. If you do not receive a prompt you can navigate to Password & Security > Change Password. Enter your temporary password and what you want your new 4 digit password to be. It is recommended that your password should be the same as your iPad password.





Saving Your Paper

Write your new password at the bottom of your sheet and take a photo. You should keep this paper as well as the photo. This will make it really easy for you to sign in the next time you forget your password.
