



What do I do if a red circle with a number pops up on settings?

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Settings

Step 1

Do not ignore!!! These numbers are not normal. Don't just leave them there, and don't overlook them.



Step 2

Open settings and see on what topic does the number notify to do something about.

Here, the number is notifying me that I haven't backed my iPad up recently.

iPad Not Backed Up



Step 3

After you have figured out why it has popped up, for example, maybe you have not backed up your iPad, you should do what it is saying hasn't been done yet. In this case, it would be to back up your iPad.

After you have realized that the iPad hasn't been backed up, then you should back it up and the red number should go away.

iPad Not Backed Up


This iPad hasn't been backed up in 45 weeks. Backups happen when this iPad is connected to power, locked, and on Wi-Fi.

If the number doesn't go away?

If you do something and the number doesn't go away, first make sure you have done everything it is asking. Sometimes there are more than one part so just make sure you have done all the parts. After you have done all the parts, the number should go away. If it still doesn't, then turn your iPad off and turn it back on and you will find that the number is gone.
