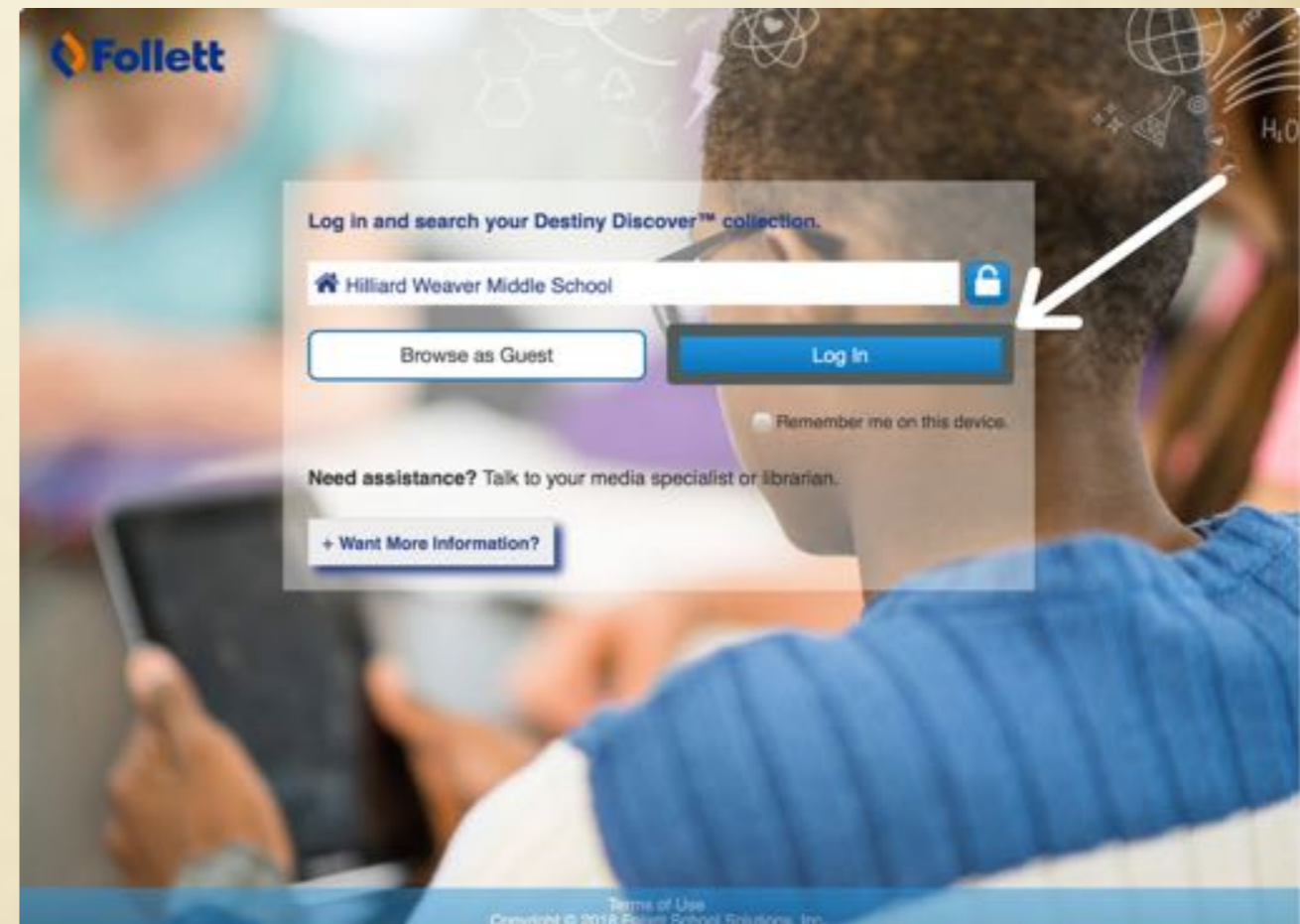

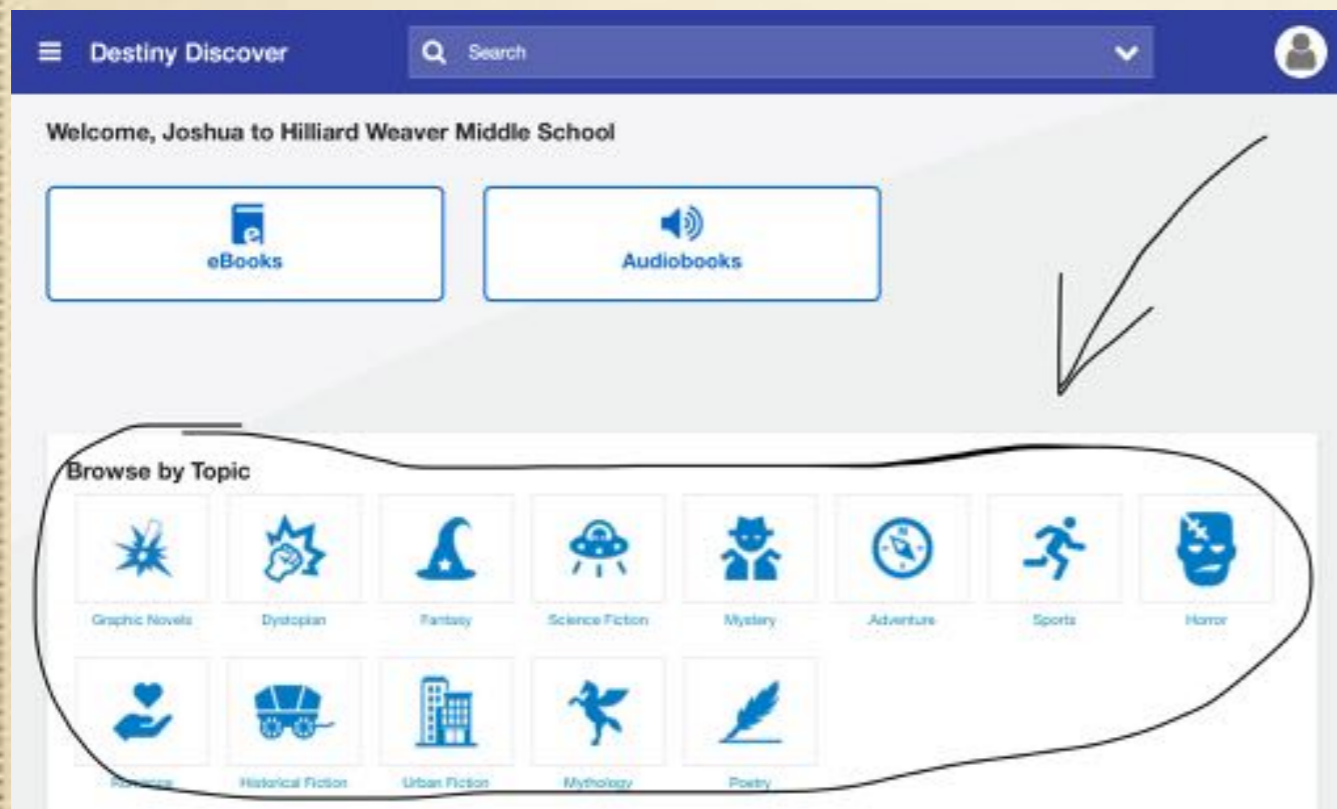

Looking for a book

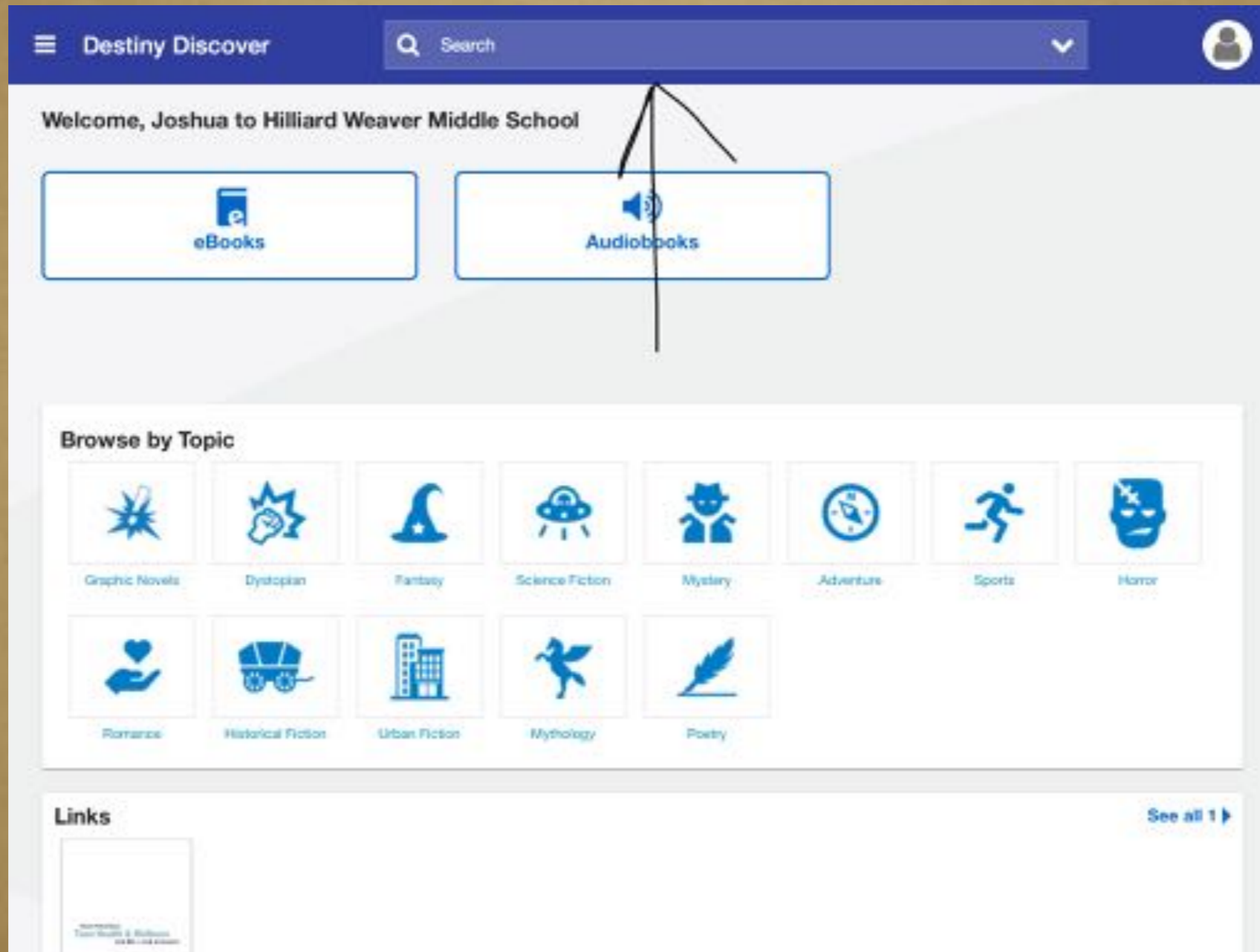
- Step 1: Is to open up the app

Step 3: Tap on the search bar, and tap on the arrow

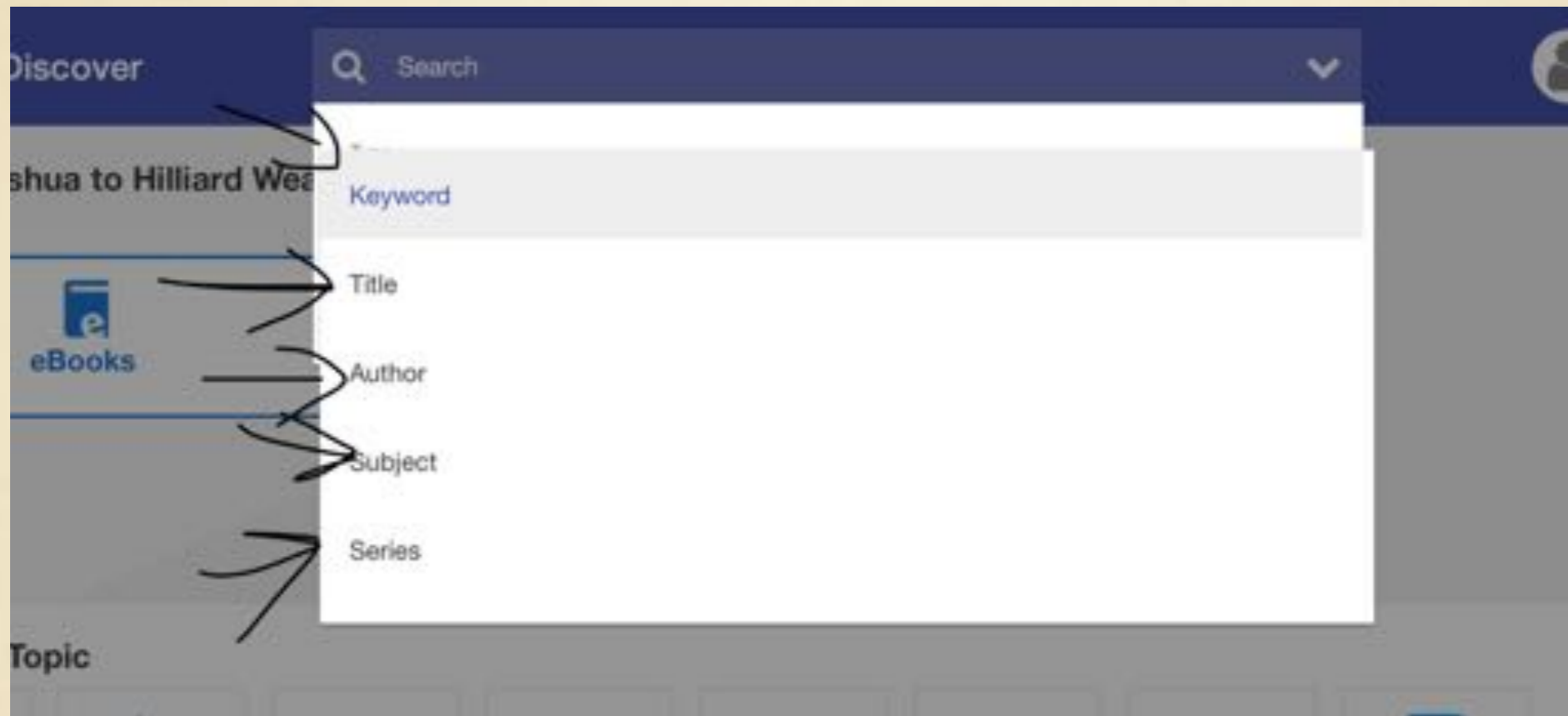

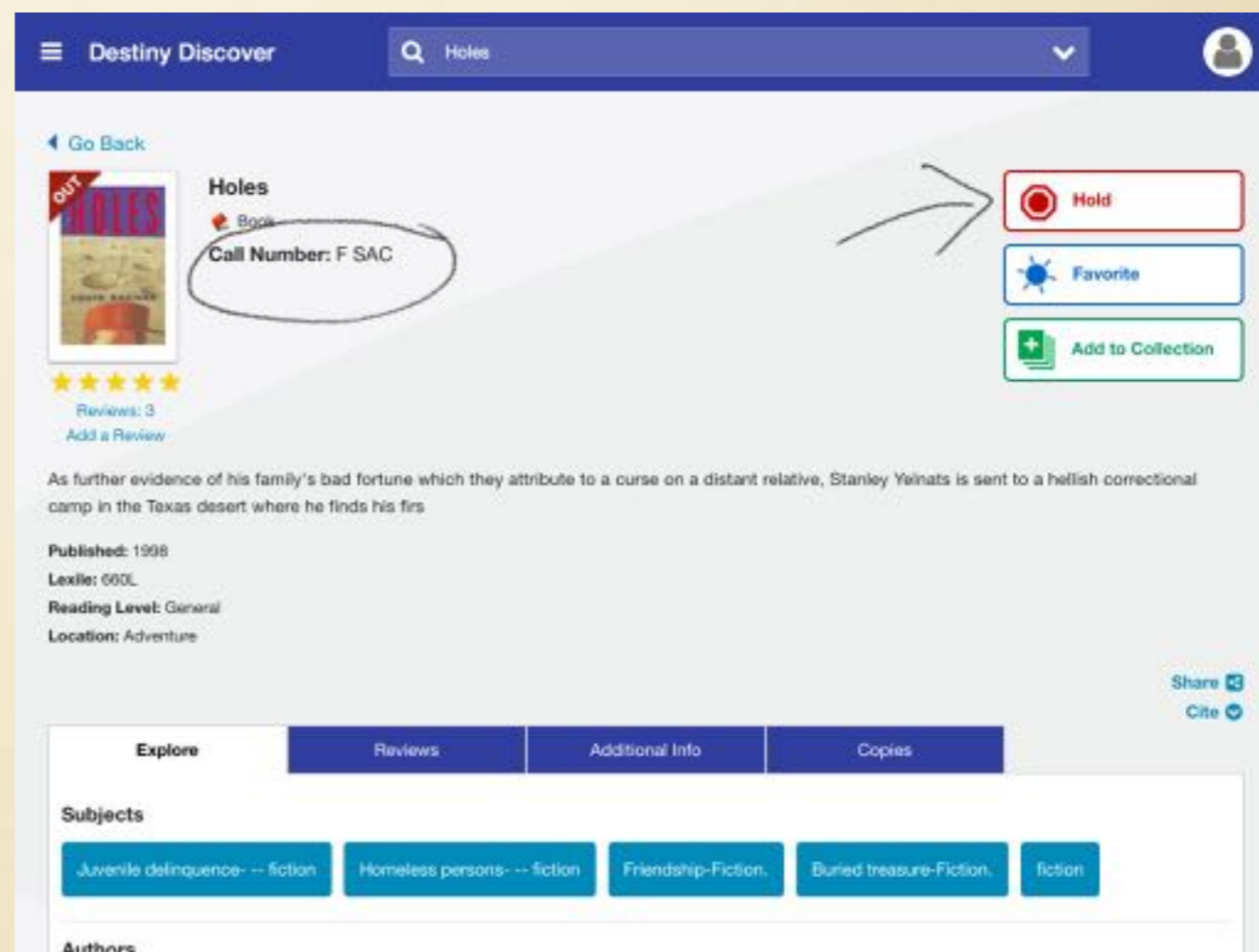
- Step 4: This is if you are looking for a book title, an author, subject, series or keyword just tap on it

- Step 6: Your book should come up or books with the same idea or title.
- On the side are some filter buttons. Using these buttons is a way to have more of an advanced search.

- Step 7: Tap on the book and the information will come up. The only thing you will need if it says “in” is the location and call number. That way you can find it. And if it says “out” you can always put a hold on it.



- Step 8: Go to the genre section (the sections are labeled) in the library. The first letter on the call number will tell you where to look. After that look for the number. Finally find the title and take it and check it out with Dr. Dorr. Of course if you are having any trouble you can always ask Dr. Dorr for help.
