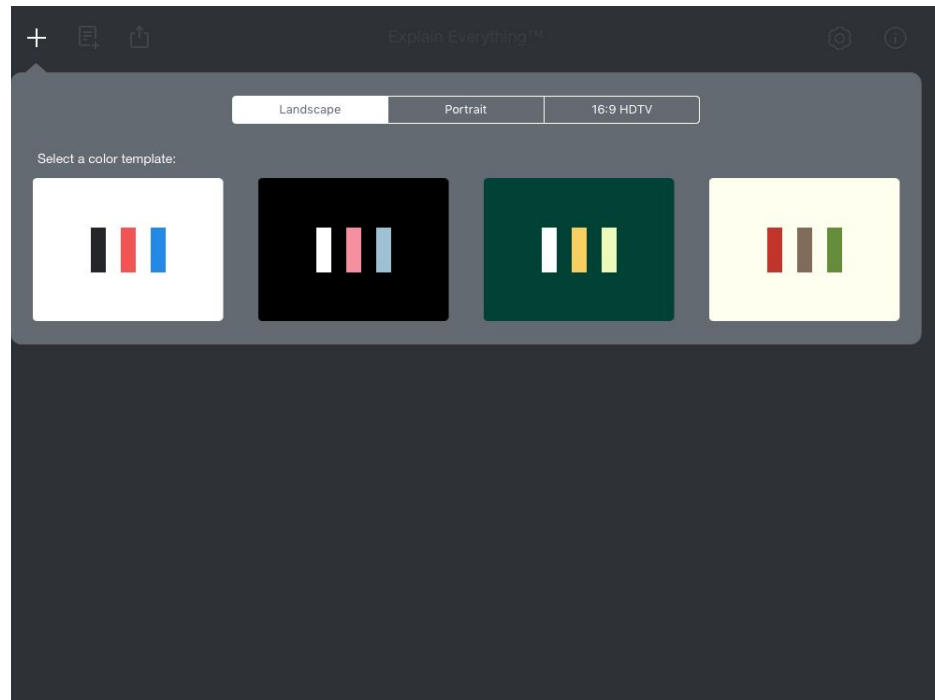
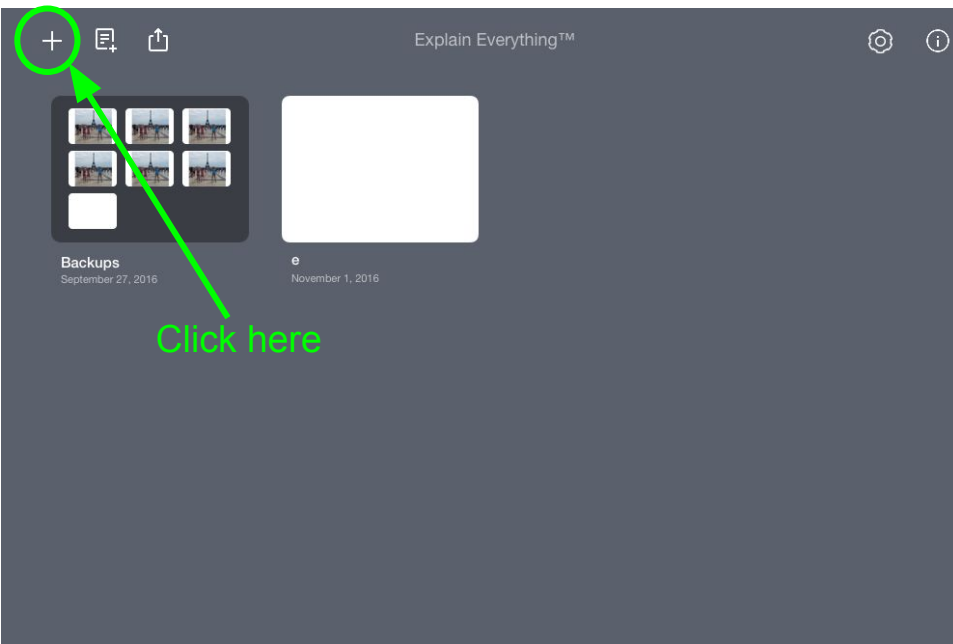
What is Explain Everything?

Explain Everything is an app that you can put pictures, videos, shapes, sounds, math equations, web browsers and more. You can also draw and type.



What do you do first?

First, you click the plus in the upper left hand corner and then tap one of the templates.



Your Options To Choose From

At this point, you have many of options you can choose from.

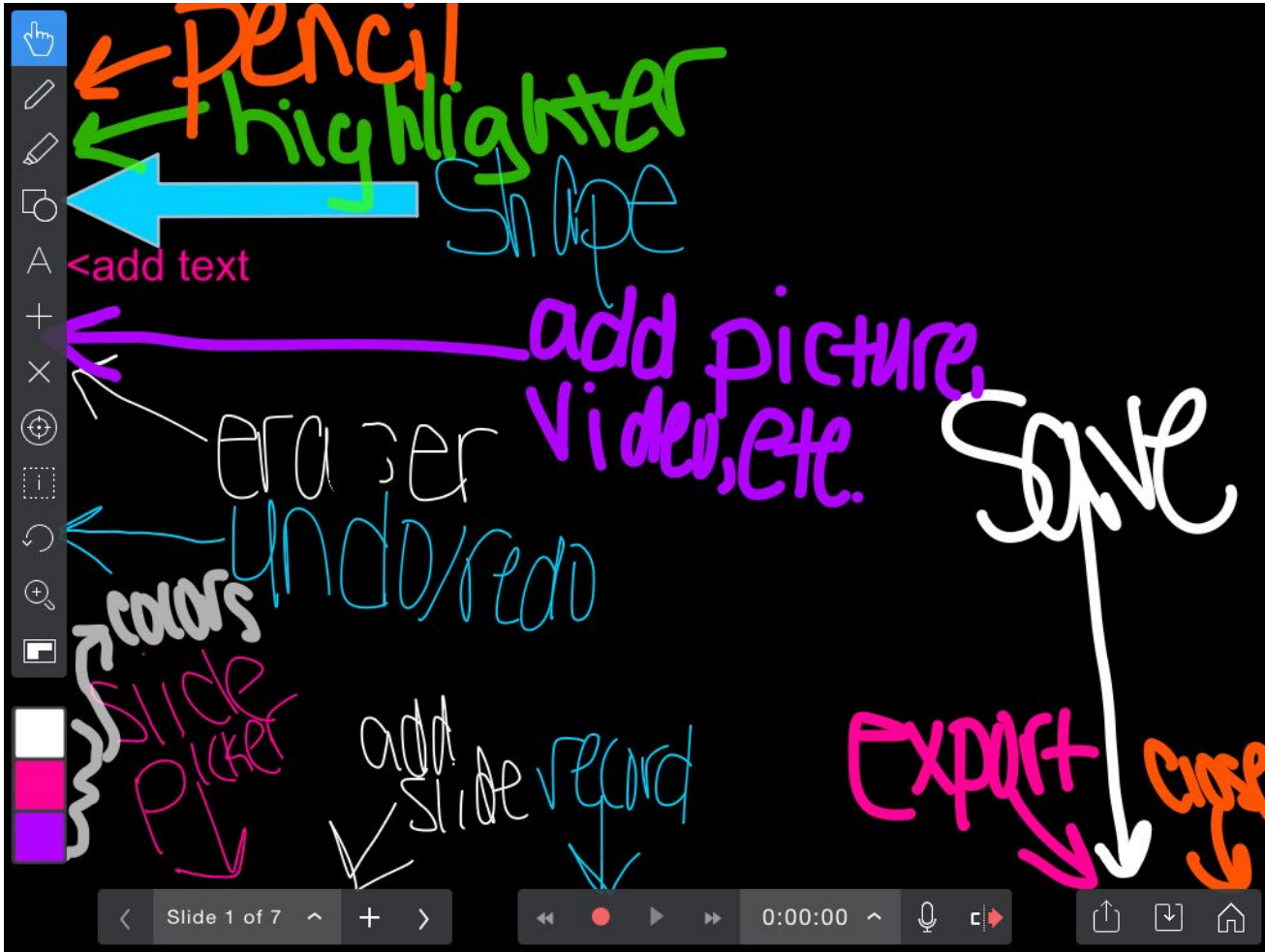
To make text or a text box: Tap the “A” on the left hand side in the box and choose your font and size and then double tap on the screen to start typing

To add a picture, video, file, sound, math equation, or web browser: Tap the “+” and select one of the options

To draw: Tap the “pencil symbol,” choose the size you want and then drag your finger on the screen to draw

To highlight: Click the “highlighter symbol,” choose the size you want and drag your finger on the screen to draw

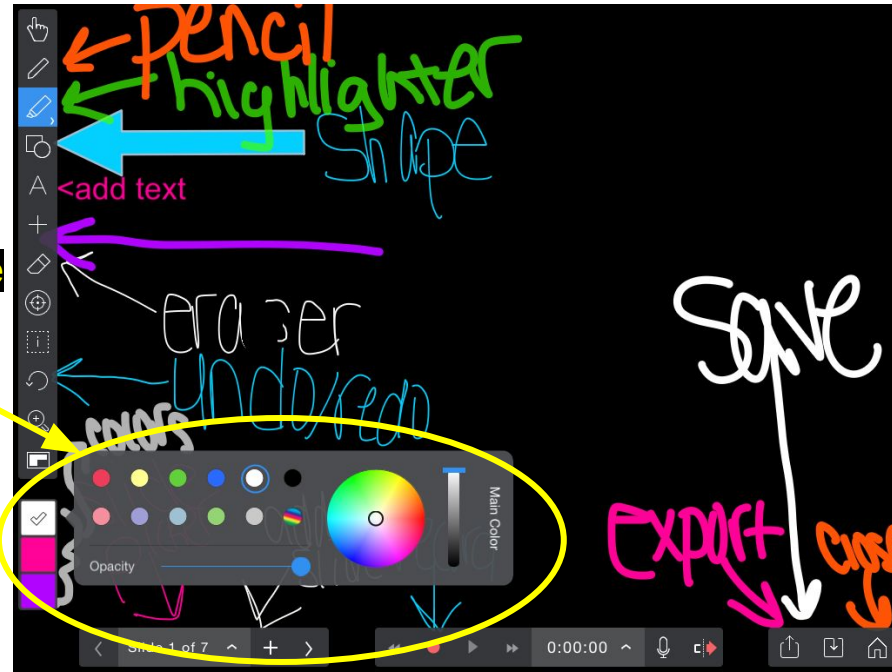

Last Editing Tips

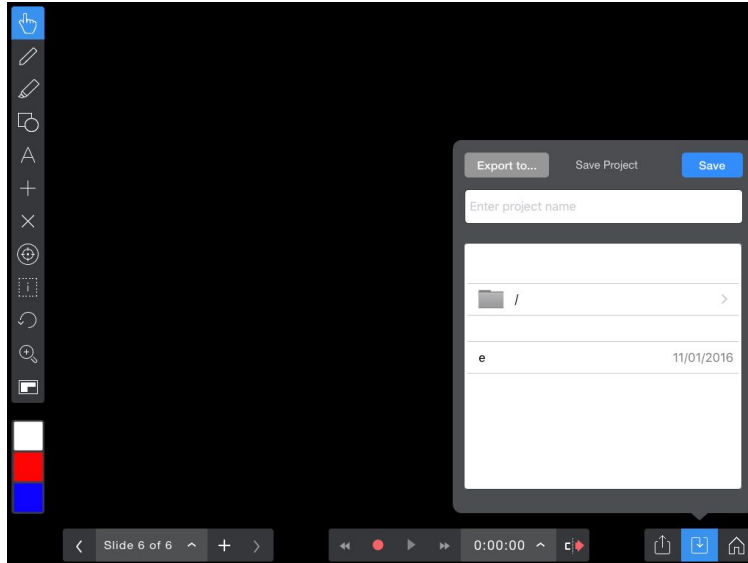
If you would like to change the color of a font, pencil, or highlighter; go to the lower left hand corner and click a color you want to change.

How to save your Explain Everything

To save your project, click the middle button in the lower right hand corner. It looks like an incomplete square with an arrow pointing downwards. Then, you will decide if you want to import it as a video, PDF, image, or Explain Everything project. After that, you can make a project name and then click a folder it will go into. Next, select where you want to import it to. Lastly, select “export.”



How to share your Explain Everything

To share your Explain Everything, click the sharrow. It looks like an incomplete square with an arrow pointing upwards. Next, decide if you want to export your project as a video, PDF, image, or Explain Everything project. Then, click where you want to export it. Lastly, click the “export” button.
