



## 2017-2018 Middle School Course Placement - Suggested Criteria

### Course Placement Process

Appropriate course placement decisions ensure a successful academic experience and avoid disruption to a student's schedule during the school year. In order to determine which course is most appropriate for your child, a committee, led by the Department of Curriculum and Instruction, analyzed the results from the *Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI)* assessment. **Please take the recommendations established through the placement process seriously** as the SRI assessment is a nationally normed assessment that has proven to be a great indicator for student placement; therefore, we are very confident that the established placement criteria is appropriate. These scores can be seen in your child's Home Access Center profile on the test score tab.

The purpose of the placement process is not to limit student or parent choice, but to ensure that such choices are based on the best available information about a student's tenacity and perseverance relative to the curricular challenges they will encounter in the coming year. Students wishing to enroll in an advanced course for the 2017-2018 school year should refer to the suggested criteria outlined below prior to making their course requests.

**Please Note: Teacher recommendation will be considered in the course placement process.** STAR Early Literacy, STAR Reading and STAR Math are computer-adaptive assessments that are used for screening, progress monitoring and diagnostic assessment of students. These applications meet all criteria for scientifically based progress-monitoring tools set by the National Center on Student Progress Monitoring.

<i>Honors English 9</i> <i>*Subject Accelerated Course</i>	Suggested criteria for placement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Grade 7 Winter STAR scaled score of 1309</b></li> <li>• <b>Successful completion of Language Arts 7 or Advanced Language Arts 7</b></li> </ul> <p><i>*NOTE: Students enrolled in this class will take the English 9 HS End of Course Test</i></p>

7 <sup>th</sup> Grade Math Courses	Suggested Criteria
<i>Math 7</i>	No placement criteria required
<i>Accelerated Math 7</i>	Suggested criteria for placement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Teacher recommendation AND Winter STAR scaled score of 838 or higher</b></li> <li>• <b>Successful completion of Math 6 or Bridge Math 6</b></li> </ul>
<i>Algebra 1</i> <i>*Subject Accelerated Course</i>	Criteria for placement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Teacher recommendation AND Successful completion of Pre-Algebra</b></li> </ul> <p><i>*NOTE: Students enrolled in this class will take the Algebra HS End of Course Test</i></p>

<b>Geometry</b> <i>*Subject Accelerated Course</i>	Criteria for placement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Teacher recommendation AND successful completion of Algebra 1</b></li> </ul> <i>*NOTE: Students enrolled in this class will take the Geometry HS End of Course Test</i>

7 <sup>th</sup> Grade Science Courses	Suggested Criteria
<b>Science 7</b>	No placement criteria required
<b>Accelerated Science 7/8</b> <i>*Subject Accelerated Course</i>	Suggested criteria for placement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Grade 6 Winter STAR Rereading scaled score of 949 or higher</b></li> <li>• <b>It is also recommended the student be enrolled in Algebra as they have shown they can succeed in an accelerated course.</b></li> </ul> <i>*NOTE: Students enrolled in this course will take the 8<sup>th</sup> grade Science Ohio's State Test</i>

8 <sup>th</sup> Grade Science Courses	Suggested Criteria
<b>Science 8</b>	No placement criteria required
<b>Honors Science 9</b> <i>*Subject Accelerated Course</i>	Criteria for placement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Successful completion of Accelerated Science 7/8</b></li> </ul>

7 <sup>th</sup> Grade Social Studies Courses	Suggested Criteria
<b>Social Studies 7</b>	No placement criteria required
<b>Advanced Social Studies 7</b>	Suggested criteria for placement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Grade 6 Winter STAR Reading scaled score of 949 or higher</b></li> </ul>
