

# Web Browser Pop-up Blocker Settings for Home Access

Windows 7: Internet Explorer 9, Internet Explorer 10, Firefox 23, Chrome 28

OS X: Firefox 23, Chrome 28, Safari 6

This document is for parents who wish to keep their web browser pop-up blocker enabled, yet allow pop-ups to display for Home Access Center (HAC). Parents who disable their pop-up blocker do not need to follow the steps below. Note OS X Safari 6 only allows pop-ups to be enabled or disabled.

## Internet Explorer 9 and 10

**Navigate to:** *Tools Pull Down Menu > Pop-Up Blocker > Pop-Up Blocker Settings*

**Add:** *homeaccess.hboe.org* to the Allowed Sites list.

**Select:** *Close* button



## Firefox 23

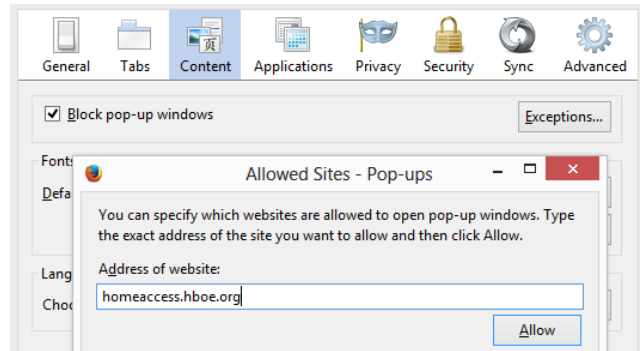
**Navigate to:**

Windows: Firefox Pull Down Menu > Options > Options > Content > Exceptions... button

OS X: Firefox Pull Down Menu > Preferences > Content > Exceptions... button

**Add:** *homeaccess.hboe.org* to the Allowed Sites list. Type under "Address of website:"

**Select:** *Allow* button



## Chrome 28

**Navigate to:**

Windows 7 & OS X: Customize and control Google Chrome Button > Settings > Show Advanced Settings... option > Privacy heading > Content Settings... button > Pop-ups heading > Manage exceptions...

**Add:** *homeaccess.hboe.org* under the Hostname pattern and select *Allow under Behavior*
