AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE OBLIGATIONS OF THE COLUMBUS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE HILLIARD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT TO EACH OTHER UNDER THE EXTENDED JOINT AGREEMENT AMONG AND BETWEEN THE BOARDS OF EDUCATION OF CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO DATED JUNE 29, 1992 AND SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED EFFECTIVE JUNE 15, 2012

This Agreement Concerning the Obligations of the Columbus City School District Board of Education (CCSD) and the Hilliard City School District Board of Education (HCSD) (each, a "Party," and collectively, the "Parties") to each under the Extended Joint Agreement Among and Between the Boards of Education of Certain School Districts of Franklin County, Ohio, dated June 29, 1992 and subsequently amended Effective June 15, 2012, (commonly known as the "Win-Win Agreement") is made to be effective August 22, 2016.

WHEREAS, the Parties are, along with certain other Boards of Education of certain school districts in Central Ohio, parties to the Win-Win Agreement and have been since 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Win-Win Agreement provides for payments to be made to the Columbus City School District Board of Education by various Boards of Education under certain circumstances as provided by Section 10 of the Win-Win Agreement;

WHEREAS, the Win-Win Agreement was renewed for a new six year period beginning July 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Win-Win Agreement, along with Section 3311.06(E) of the Ohio Revised Code, permits the Parties to enter into a bilateral agreement on issues that only affect their school districts; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2016, the Board of Education of the Columbus City School District adopted a resolution which, among other things, directed its Superintendent to begin negotiations with the Superintendents of the school districts participating in the Win-Win Agreements to achieve a transition from the Win-Win Agreement as presently constituted to individual district agreements which would become effective in June 2017; and

WHEREAS, the May 23, 2016 resolution of the Board of Education of the Columbus City School District directed its Superintendent to negotiate in those individual agreements terms which would (1) continue Section 10 payments for the first year of the new six-year term of the Win-Win Agreement; (2) phase out Section 10 payments over a 5-year period; and (3) identify areas which shall not be eligible for transfer.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to enter into an agreement adjusting only their obligations to each other under the Win-Win Agreement in accordance with the May 23, 2016 resolution and which do not affect any of the other Boards of Education that are parties to the Win-Win Agreement.

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF the foregoing and of the promises and covenants hereinafter set forth, it is agreed between the Parties as follows:

Section 1. Purpose of the Agreement. The purpose of this Agreement is to establish a payment schedule which phases out over a five-year period the compensation payable by HCSD to CCSD under Section 10 of the Win-Win Agreement and to provide for stability of boundaries. The terms of this Agreement shall be permanent, except as otherwise provided herein.

Section 2. Amendment to Section 10 Payment Computations. The Parties agree that the amount to be paid by the Hilliard City School District to the Columbus City School District under Section 10 of the Win-Win Agreement shall be computed as follows:

The payment due May,2017 shall be the full amount due under the Win-Win Agreement;

The payment due May 2018 shall be 80% of the amount then due and owing under the Win-Win Agreement;

The payment due May 2019 shall be 60% of the amount then due and owing under the Win-Win Agreement;

The payment due May 2020 shall be 40% of the amount then due and owing under the Win-Win Agreement;

The payment due May 2021 shall be 20% of the amount then due and owing under the Win-Win Agreement.

No payment shall be due after the payment for May 2021 unless otherwise agreed by the Parties.

Section 3. Disposition of Annexed Territory

Permanency of Boundaries between HCSD and CCSD. In order to provide for stability of boundaries between the Hilliard City School District and Columbus City School District, and not withstanding any provision of the Win-Win Agreement to the contrary, neither Party shall request or effectuate the transfer of any property for school purposes from the other district into the requesting party's district.

Section 4. Cooperation in Obtaining Approvals. The Parties agree to work cooperatively to take all steps necessary to obtain any approvals that may be necessary to effectuate this Agreement.

Section 5. Terms of the Agreement

This Agreement is intended to and shall affect only the Columbus City School District and the Hilliard City School District. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to or shall be construed as affecting any other school district which is a party to the Win-Win Agreement.

This Agreement may only be amended by a written agreement executed by each Party and approved by Board resolution.

This Agreement, together with the Win-Win Agreement, represents the complete understanding and agreement of the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof.

This Agreement is the product of negotiations by both Parties and each Party shall be considered a drafter of this Agreement. Accordingly, this Agreement shall not be subject to the principle of contract interpretation that a contract is construed against the drafter of the contract.

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts by the Parties, with each such counterpart to constitute an original of the entire Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, each of the Boards of Education have, by Resolution and through their respective representatives, authorized and directed the execution of this Agreement.
