A RESOLUTION APPROVING SALE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF HILLIARD, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Board is the owner of certain real property containing approximately 5.18 acres currently identified as Franklin County tax parcel numbers 050-000151 and 050-003188 (the "Madison Street Property");

WHEREAS, the City of Hilliard, Ohio (the "City") desires to purchase 0.346 ±acres of the Madison Street Property (the "Subject Property") from the School District; and

WHEREAS, the Administration of the School District and the City have agreed to the terms of the sale of the Subject Property, including the waiver of water tap fees related to the construction of the new middle school by the City in return for the sale of the Subject Property to the City at no cost, subject to the restrictions and covenants contained in the deed attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Deed");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Hilliard City School District, Counties of Franklin and Union, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. This Board hereby determines that the Subject Property is no longer needed for any school purpose and is valued at more than 10,000, and approves and authorizes the sale of the Initial Property in the manner provided by Section 3313.41(C) of the Revised Code.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Board hereby approves the form of the Deed for the Subject Property attached hereto as Exhibit A, and authorizes the President or Vice President and the Treasurer/CFO of the Board, in the name and on behalf of, the Board to execute and deliver the Deed in substantially its current form with such changes that are not materially adverse to the School District, that are permitted by law and approved by the officers executing the Deed. The approval of any changes, and that such changes are not materially adverse to the School District, shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution of the Deed by the President or Vice-President and Treasurer/CFO of this Board.

<u>Section 3</u>. The President or Vice-President and the Treasurer/CFO of this Board or other School District officials as shall be designated by those officials, as appropriate, are each authorized and directed to do all things necessary and consistent with this Resolution and to take such actions as are necessary or appropriate to accomplish the sale approved herein, including entering into agreements and executing other documents as permitted by applicable law.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution, and all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions, were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
