CHILD FIND **FOR** **CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES**

If you know of a child or suspect a child may have a disability who resides in the Hilliard City School District attendance area, please contact:

Public schools are required by Federal law to find all children who may have disabilities, ages birth through 21, and provide special education services for any children, ages 3 to 21, identified as disabled under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (IDEIA). Disabilities under IDEIA include: preschooler with a disability, speech and language, hearing impairments, visual impairments, specific learning disability, emotional disturbance, multiple disabilities, mental retardation, other health impairments, orthopedic disability, autism and traumatic brain injury. If after an evaluation, a child is determined to have a disability under IDEIA, the child is eligible to receive special education services through the school district.

All information related to the referral, evaluation, identification and special education services is confidential information. Parents retain specific rights related to confidentiality, review of records, release of information and accuracy of records for any child referred to special education, identified as special education or who receives special education services.
