Part 1- Gather a collection of 30 - 40 objects (can be coins, matchbox cars, blocks paperclips, etc). Print the attached 1-20 numeral cards (or use playing cards or write the numerals 1-20 on index cards or a piece of paper). Have your child select a card and count out a matching quantity from the large group of objects. Make as many smaller sets of objects as possible from the larger set. When you are no longer able to make a set to match the cards push the objects back together and play again.

<u>Part 2</u> – Gather a collection of 20 objects (can be coins, matchbox cars, blocks paperclips, etc). Use the numeral cards 1-10 (from the previous activity) and place them face down. Have your child turn over a card and make 3 collections – one that is the *same* as the numeral card, one that is *more* than the numeral card and one that is *less* the than numeral card.
