BOARD OPERATION GOALS

The primary responsibility of the Board is to guide District operations through the process of strategic planning and formulation of policies which support the educational philosophies in the District's planning document(s) and supporting operational goals. The Board must fulfill these responsibilities while exercising prudent fiscal management. Achievement of the following goals will be accomplished through the selection and evaluation of the District's executive officer(s) for the implementation of these plans and policies.

In accordance with these principles, the Board shall seek to achieve the following goals:

- 1. to concentrate the Board's collective effort on its policy-making and planning responsibilities;
- 2. to formulate Board policies which best serve the educational interests of each student;
- 3. to provide the Superintendent/CEO with sufficient and adequate guidelines for implementing Board policies;
- 4. to provide direction to the Treasurer/CFO in development of the District's financial plan, assure its consistency with the strategic plan and confirm that its implementation meets the requirements of prudent fiscal management;
- 5. to maintain effective communication with the school community, the staff and students in order to maintain awareness of attitudes, opinions, desires and ideas;
- 6. to conduct Board business openly, soliciting and encouraging broad-based involvement in the Board's decision-making processes by public, students and staff and
- 7. to periodically review its performance relative to the goals.
