

## SAFETY PROGRAM

The Board is concerned with the safety of all students, employees and members of the school community present on District property and at all District-sponsored events at other sites. The Board directs the administration to develop a safety program which is reviewed on an ongoing basis.

The Superintendent/designee has responsibility for the safety program of the District and develops written procedures to comply with all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations.

The practice of safety is also a part of the instructional plan of the District through educational programs. Staff will be trained as required by law. The educational program includes, but is not limited to, instruction in traffic and pedestrian safety, fire prevention, physical and emotional well-being, in-service training and emergency procedures appropriately geared to students and staff at different grade levels.

All stakeholders are encouraged to be informed, participate and comply in the safety practices of the District by providing recommendations that ensure a safe environment for all.
