

RECORDING DEVICES ON TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES

The Board, as part of the District's ongoing program to improve student discipline and ensure the health, welfare and safety of all those riding school transportation vehicles, may utilize video and audio recording devices on school vehicles transporting students to and from curricular and extracurricular activities.

The recording devices monitor student behavior and the recordings are hereby stipulated as admissible evidence in student disciplinary proceedings. The recordings may be subject to student records confidentiality and are subject to Board policy and administrative regulations.

The Superintendent/designee is directed to develop administrative regulations governing the use of recording devices in accordance with the provisions of law and this policy.
