PLEASE READ THESE RULES & EXPECTATIONS THOROUGHLY

Memorial Middle School Talent Show Rules and Regulations

1. All performing members must be students in good standing at Memorial Middle School.
2. All participants in acts must be students at Memorial Middle School. Performers may not receive assistance from an adult (parent or otherwise) or another student from a different school.
3. All acts should be age appropriate and school appropriate. Any offensive acts with suggestive lyrics, dancing, or offensive material will be disqualified.
4. All acts must be under 3 minutes and 30 seconds. If necessary, acts will be cut down to fit the allotted time.
5. **Not all auditioned acts will qualify for the final performance.**
6. **Your audition must be fully prepared and show exactly what you plan to do for the final performance.** If your costume is available, we would prefer that you wear it for the audition. Acts that are incomplete or ill prepared will not be put in the final show. ****Missing equipment or lack of accompaniment will automatically disqualify you from consideration.****
7. Ms. Burkett must approve your final performance outfit.
8. All talents are welcome: singers, dancers, rappers, bands, groups, instrumentalists, jugglers, comedians, unicyclists, etc. All acts must be appropriate for school audiences.
9. Singers must supply their own accompanist or CD/MP3. All CDs/MP3 should be free of lead vocals. **YouTube Karaoke tracks are NOT acceptable forms of accompaniment.** **Any singers who sing along with a CD/MP3 that has main vocals on it will be disqualified.**
10. Instrumentalists must supply their own instruments, extension cords, keyboards, and amps. One acoustic piano is available.
11. All interested students must audition in the MMS Choir Room (Room 164) between the hours of 2:30 and 4:30 PM on Wednesday, May 22. No special audition times are available.
12. Results of the auditions will be posted outside the choir room on Friday, May 24 at the end of the school day.
13. The **signed** registration form must be returned to Ms. Burkett no later than Friday, May 17 at 2:45 PM. ***No late registration forms will be accepted.***
14. ***All performers must attend the mandatory dress rehearsal/run through on Thursday, May 30 from 2:45-4:30 PM. If you are not able to attend, you will not participate in the final show.***
15. You will receive your audition time on a first come, first serve basis. Requested audition times will be honored in the order that they are received.
16. No parents are permitted in the judging/audition area. You may wait for your child in the pickup zones outside the school.
17. All judges' decisions are final.

18. Failure to abide by any rules will result in immediate dismissal from the talent show.
