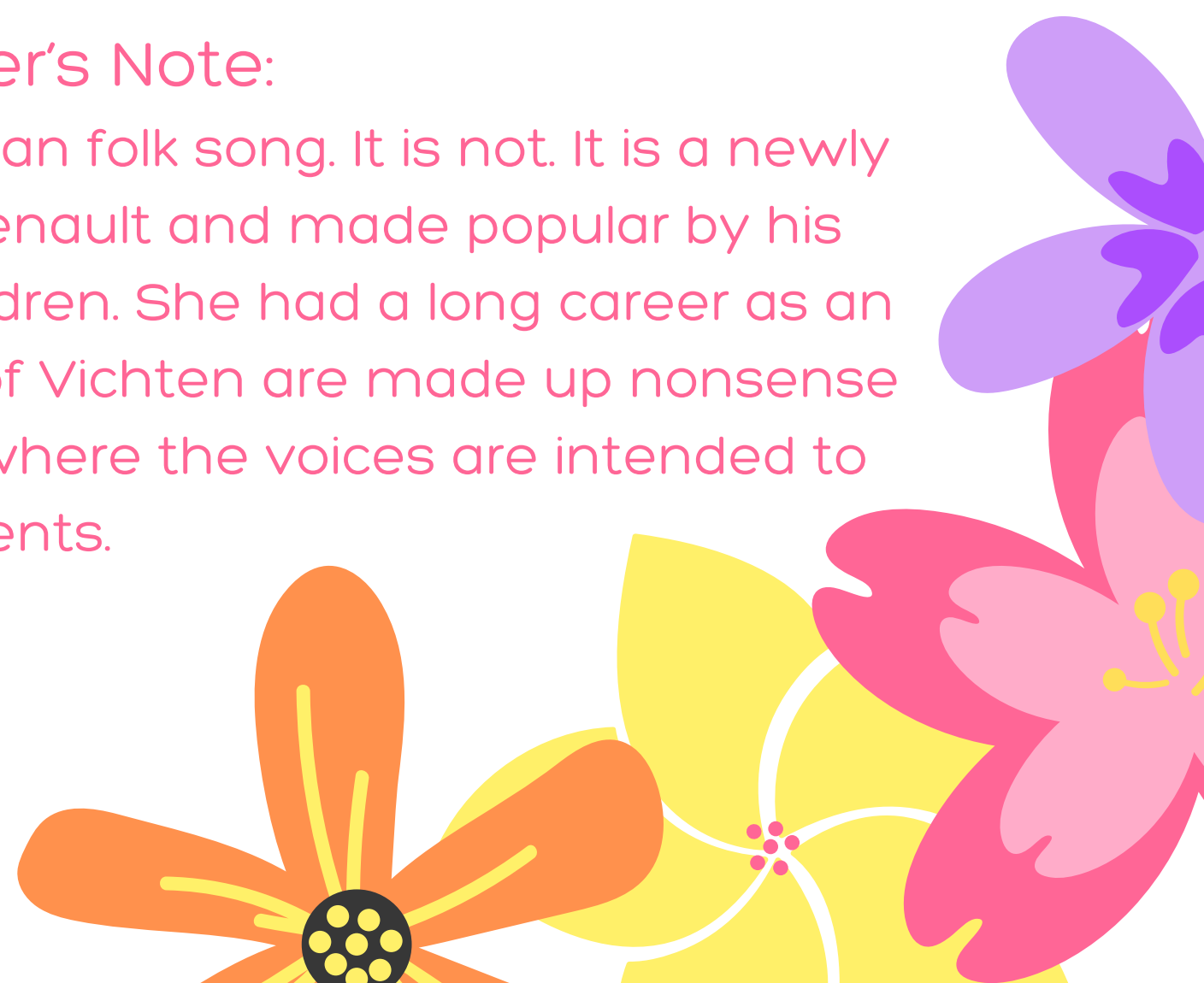

'Vichten' Composer's Note:

Many mistake 'Vichten' for a traditional Acadian folk song. It is not. It is a newly composed folk song written by Arthur Arsenault and made popular by his daughter Angele Arsenault, the 8th of 14 children. She had a long career as an Acadian folk singer and TV host. The words of Vichten are made up nonsense syllables similar to Scottish 'mouth music' where the voices are intended to mimic instruments.
