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Main Stage Production Student Agreement- By signing below, both the student and their parent/guardian acknowledge and agree to the following expectations and responsibilities associated with participation in a main stage production at Darby Theatre:

1. Rehearsal Commitment

We understand and agree to attend all scheduled rehearsals and performance dates. We also acknowledge that the rehearsal schedule is subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. We agree to be flexible and responsive to such changes. Additionally, we recognize that some rehearsals—especially during Tech Week and Strike—may extend late into the evening, and we commit to making arrangements to fully participate in those events.

2. Academic Requirements

Participation in the main stage production is contingent upon maintaining good academic standing, in accordance with the Darby Theatre Handbook and the Darby High School Student Handbook. The student agrees to uphold a minimum GPA of 2.0 and not be on academic probation at any point during the rehearsal and performance period.

- If the student's GPA falls below a 2.0, or if they are placed on academic probation, they will become ineligible to participate in the production.
- It is the student's responsibility to monitor their academic progress and communicate with the director if any academic concerns arise.
