I. SECRETARY'S REPORT: Minutes from the January meeting were reviewed and approved with minor edits.

II. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT.

 - Crystal has worked with Texas Roadhouse and we will do a rolls and butter fundraiser - rolls sell for \$5.00 per dozen and an 8 oz. tub of cinnamon butter sells for \$2.00. PTO will receive 50% of the proceeds.
 - Mindy confirmed we cannot organize a student dance, due to logistics
 - We will work with Mindy to share a PTO promotional letter; something geared toward incoming freshman parents, and all parents, allowing them to donate money in lieu of time for things like cookie day and teacher dinners.
