MEETING DATE: NOVEMBER 6, 2018

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Minutes from the October 2nd meeting were reviewed and approved upon motion by President Billman with a second by Treasurer Letcavits.

NEW BUSINESS:

I. TREASURER'S REPORT.

- 1. We received an additional \$100.00 local business donation resulting from the solicitation letter to local businesses. The donation was received from Molly Maid. Donations to date from this effort total \$235.00, pending receipt of the \$35.00 Target gift card.
- The 2018-2019 budget was distributed with updated balances. Key updates included:
 - Kroger Rewards and Amazon Smiles funds added
 - \$150 Leadership Retreat donation
 - Adjustments for cancellation of Bradley Cares and Shares 5k (40 registrants donated their fees and 5 refunds were processed. Processing fees of \$1.00 + 3% of each transaction. Angie received a \$20.00 donation from a neighbor
- 3. Crystal provided the ISPTO invoice to the Treasurer for payment.

II. SUPERINTENDENT'S LUNCHEON.

Angle attended the most recent Superintendent's Luncheon and provided an update. There were 3 speakers:

- Mark Pohlman, Director of Instructional Technology, provided an update on district ipads.
 There are currently 18,000 ipads in circulation across the district and we are on a 4-year
 replacement cycle. Current technology focuses are on blended learning and digital
 wellness.
- Molly Walker, Director of Social Emotional Learning & Measurement, spoke regarding emotional learning. Their biggest concern is students not having a sense of belonging.
- Vicky Clark, Assistant Superintendent, spoke regarding the upcoming Parent University and Book Talks.

III. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT.

- The most recent Parent University featured a showing of the film <u>Angst</u>. Teachers also viewed the film, in addition to all students.
- Eighty (80) students received Student of Quarter. Teachers nominate students based on the theme, Power of the Team.
- The end of semester schedule is going back to the original schedule. Students do not need to be at school if they do not have a scheduled assessment. Dates are December 19, 20, 21.

- Getting ready for Air Test (week of December 3rd). The District purchased 50 seats/licenses for the Apex online study assistance program.
- The Special Ed class has requested a Benevolent Fund donation to assist with their in-class Thanksgiving meal. Students will be shopping, cooking, and serving the meal for students and staff. They do not have a budget, but would appreciate any donations.

IV. NEW BUSINESS.

- 1. Jerri Letcavits attended the Treasurer's Workshop hosted by the ISPTO. She shared the handouts from that workshop. Key highlights:
 - The 5-year Secretary of State filing will be due in June
 - The ISPTO is going to work on developing an outline of the current fundraising guidelines
 - Jerri learned that we can use PayPal to accept payments without incurring fees, like the \$1.00 or 3% fee charged by Local Level. This can be advertised on the PTO website and in Mindy's announcements, to help spread the word.
- 2. Benevolent Fund Request. The group discussed and voted on the Special Ed class's request for a donation to help with their in-class Thanksgiving meal. A motion was passed to donate a grocery store gift card in the amount of \$75.00.
