Score 18 Points on State Tests

Obio's State Tests

Earn at least 18 points on seven end-of-course state tests. End-of-course tests are:

Algebra I or Integrated Math I Geometry or Integrated Math II American Government American History English I English B Biology

Each test score earns you up to five graduation points, You must have a minimum of four points in math, four points in English and six points across science and social studies. You school and district necesse grades on the Onio School Report Cards for all students' scores and participation on stare tests.

18 Points on State Tests

For each of the seven end-of-course state tests, a student earns one to five graduation points. Students have the potential so earn a total of 35 points. To meet this graduation option, a student must earn a minimum number of 18 points from the seven test.

This graduation option gives a student flexibility in accumulating 18 points. A high score on one test can balance a low score on another test. A student must para a total of at least four points on Employ tests, four points on math tests and six points on science and six points students.
