What Is Home Access Center?

Home Access Center (HAC) is a web-based program, offered to Parents/Guardians of our students, to further communication between home and school.

What Can I See On HAC?

HAC allows you to view report cards, attendance, transcripts, graduation plan, course requests, discipline incidents, classes/classwork, and scheduling information for your student(s). You also use Home Access Center to update emergency contacts on a yearly basis and to complete athletic eligibility information. You will find a link to the 2021/2022 Program of Studies on HAC as well as a link to MyPaymentsPlus.

If you are new to Hilliard City School District, your username and password for Home Access Center will be the same as the login information you used to register your child for school. If you currently have students in the district and are registering a new student, your Home Access login information will be what you currently use to get into Home Access Center. Access for non-custodial parents or shared parents can be attained by contacting your child's school.

What Do I Do If I Have A Problem Logging Into HAC?

If you have forgotten your User Name, please call your student's school. However, If you have forgotten your password or have been locked out of your account, please visit the parent portal at www.password.hboe.org. You may be able to resolve these issues yourself.
