Columbus Public Library's Winter Reading Challenge


- Reading program takes place January 5th-February 27th



Promoting Literacy at Home



Read Every Day

Even a brief daily commitment can convey that reading is an important priority.



Visit the Library

Getting your child a library card can get them excited about books. Make these trips fun.



Make a Space for Reading

Create a cozy, consistent place in your home where you can enjoy books together.



Seek Out Adaptations

Read books that are being adapted into movies. Rent audiobooks from the library with the Libby app!



Make Reading Silly

Don't be afraid to get silly, reading should be fun.



Partner with Teachers

Work with teachers to understand their approach to literacy and ask how you can help at home.

 - Narrate what you are doing.
 - Get your child's full attention & chat.
- Read Together & Chat About It
- Listen to Podcasts Together




