Meeting Minutes for

November 12, 2018

Four in attendance: Kimberly Van Gundy, Matt Anderson, Megan Kolb, and Lucy West

President's Welcome: Kimberly Van Gundy called the meeting to order.

Principal's Report: Matt Anderson opened his comments regarding Davidson athletes – Boys and Girls Cross Country teams went to States. Boys ranked 2nd overall and Girls ranked 7th overall. Davidson Football are still in the play offs. Athletic Signing is Wednesday, Nov 14th at 7:15pm and Fall Athletic Awards are also on Wednesday, Nov 14th starting at 6:30pm.

The Variety Show is no longer a fundraiser due to requirements of the Hilliard School district. Evening performance for parents is on Thurs, Nov 15th at 7pm and the in-school performance for students is on Nov 20th.

Treasurer Report: Megan Kolb provided copies of October 2018 Report Highlights and Treasurer Report for the period 10/1/18 – 10/31/18. We expected to sell 200 Smoothies at \$4.00. Final count was 75 @ \$4.00; 25 @ \$3.00; 75 @ \$2.00 and 25 free. Motion was made to approve Treasurer's Report and report was approved with no dissents.
