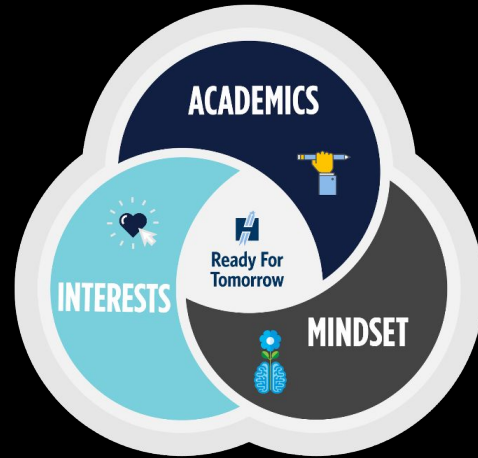

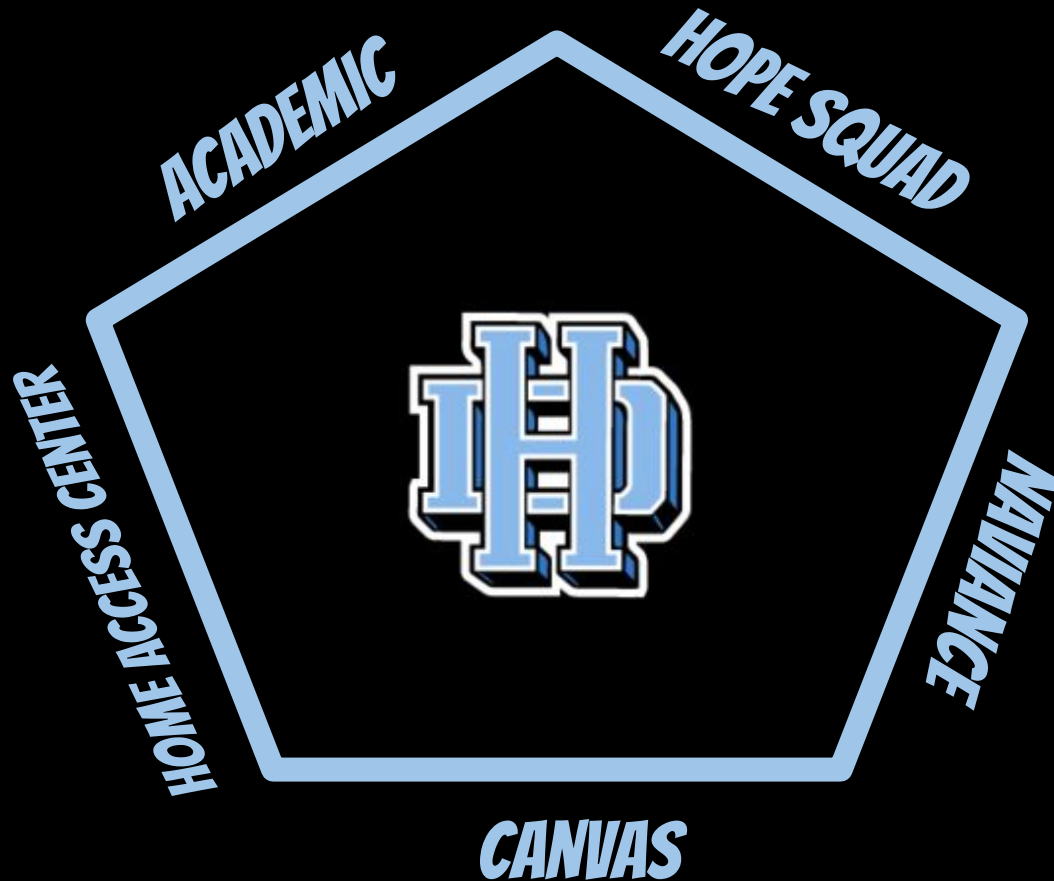

THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

- TODAY, HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELORS MET WITH ALL CURRENT 8TH GRADERS TO TALK THROUGH SCHEDULING, GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS, AND HELP STUDENTS ENTER COURSE REQUESTS
- STUDENTS CAN TALK WITH PARENTS/GUARDIANS IN ORDER TO ADJUST/FINALIZE REQUESTS
- FRIDAY, JANUARY 24TH, DARBY COUNSELORS WILL MEET ONE-ON-ONE WITH 8TH GRADERS TO LOOK OVER REQUESTS AND ANSWER QUESTIONS
