Hello everyone,

My name is Jay Smith and I am the Assistant Athletic Director serving Heritage Middle School and Darby High School. As we head into our first week of regular season events I wanted to be sure that everyone has the same information. Hilliard Heritage and Hilliard Darby do charge admissions to athletic events. I do not want this to be a surprise as you plan to attend your child's events. Home events will cost Adults \$5, Students/Sr. \$3 and under 5 is Free (Middle School Events), while Adults \$7, Students/Sr. \$5 and under 5 Free (High School Events.). All admissions collected to go directly back into supporting all programs at Heritage and Darby. This is the bulk of our athletic budget from year to year. We do offer Athletic Passes, that cover both Heritage and Darby events, for purchase in the Athletic office. Attached is information on ordering athletic passes for the Winter/Spring seasons.
