

It is with great excitement that I share with you that Heritage Middle School has been recognized by the Ohio Department of Education with the 'Momentum Award'. This award recognizes schools who improved their performance rating on the state report card by 3 or more points AND received a value-added rating of 4 or more starts. Only 10% of ALL Ohio Public schools fell into this category. We are extremely proud of our students and teachers and appreciate the positive recognition.

Next Wednesday, April 17th, will be our next Ohio State Testing day. This time around, testing will only be occurring for our 8th grade students in the area of Science. 7th grade students are still expected to report at the regular time and will rotate through an alternative schedule while the 8th graders test. If your student starts their day anywhere on the Innovation Campus, they should report to Heritage first. Bussing to and from the Innovation Campus will resume once testing concludes.
