Station 6th Grade Information




- School day begins at 7:55am (tardy bell) and ends at 2:40 pm.
 - School doors open at 7:40 am.
 - Breakfast is served from 7:40 am 7:55 am
 - There are 8 teams each with approximately 100 students.

 - PAW Days in the summer to help orient students to their new building and schedule.
 - August 11 (Morning and Evening) and Aug 12 (Afternoon)
 - Extracurricular activities are offered after school & other special events occur throughout the year!



Key Points:

- Every Student will start the school day in Power Up. (May have been known as Morning Meeting in their Elementary)

Requesting Elective Courses


Elementary Visits Feb 10 thru Feb 20

Full year ensambles requests are prioritized.







Math Placement

- •Proper placement is the correct balance between *challenge* & *enrichment* vs. *frustration* & *discouragement*
- Misplaced students begin to struggle and often become extremely overwhelmed
- •Once on this rapidly accelerating trajectory it is often hard to get back on a more appropriate placement.
- •Misplaced 6th grade Accelerated Math 7 students often end up repeating or taking remedial math courses at the high school level.



Honors Math 6 Placement Criteria

Successful Completion of Math 5 with Teacher Recommendation AND Winter STAR Scaled Score of 797*

Accelerated Math 7 Placement Criteria

Successful Completion of Math 5 with Teacher Recommendation AND

Winter STAR Scaled Score of 863*



These courses may be:


- Focus Period (Students who receive IEP and EL supports)
