# Project Status

- All 6 projects have been reviewed by the building department, and we have received phased approval for each.

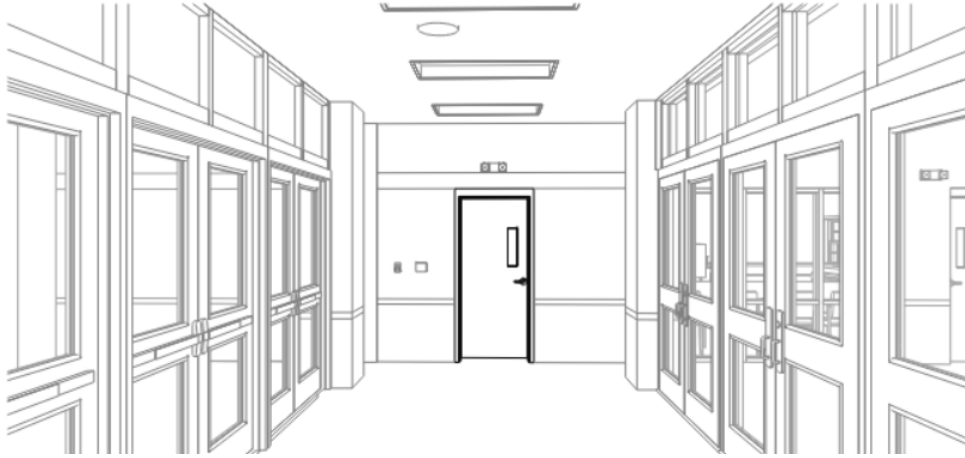

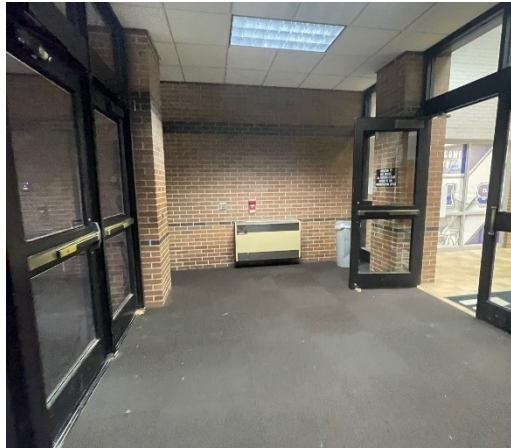

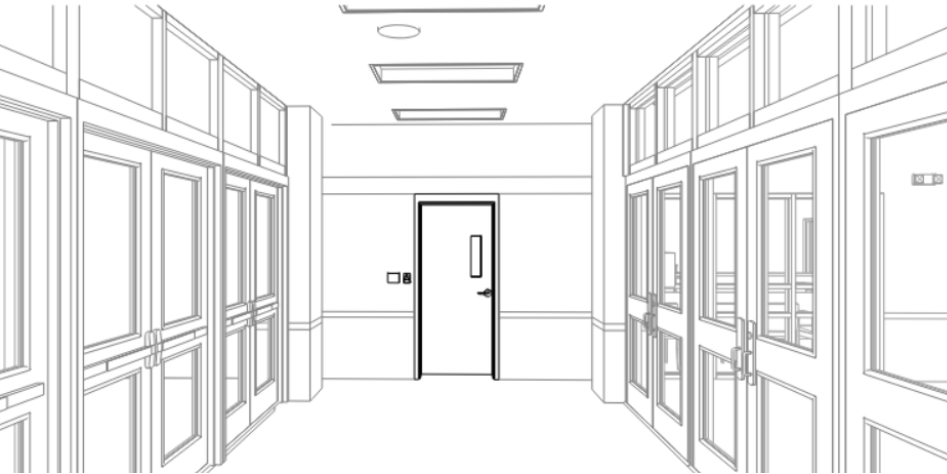

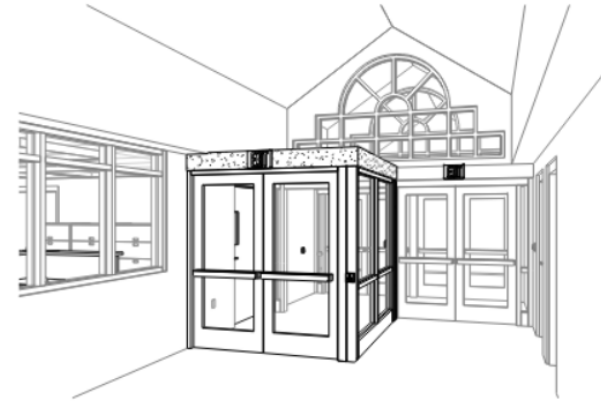
