Community

Hilliard is a suburban, residential community located northwest of Columbus, Ohio. The District encompasses approximately 60 square miles which includes portions of the City of Columbus, the City of Dublin and five surrounding townships. The community is one of the fastest-growing in the state of Ohio with over 96,000 residents and over 16,300 school students. The district celebrates diversity through its current rapid growth.

School

Hilliard Davidson High School is a four-year comprehensive public school of 1877 students. School is in session 176 days a year. The academic year is divided into two semesters with four nine-week grading periods. Class periods are forty-eight minutes in length.

Faculty

Hilliard Davidson High School has 124 certificated professional staff. Of the certificated staff, 98 have earned advanced degrees.

Graduation Requirements

Hilliard Davidson is a comprehensive high school that includes college preparatory, honors, Advanced Placement, dual enrollment, occupational, vocational and adjustment programs. Students must meet the following requirements to graduate: Demonstrate competency on the Algebra I and English Language Arts II state test (or through alternative demonstrations), demonstrate readiness for post-high school by earning two seals including a state defined seal, and complete 21.5 credits that include:

English - 4 credits	Mathematics - 4 credits (must include Alg. 2 or equivalent)
US Government - 1 credit	Science - 3 credits (1 credit Biology; 1 credit Phys. Sci.)
US History - 1 credit	Health - .5 credit
World Studies - 1 credit	Physical Education - .5 credits
Financial Literacy Elective - .5 credit	Digital Connections/Future Ready - .5 credit
Senior Capstone - .5 credit	Additional Electives - 5 credits

Advanced Placement and Honors

Advanced Placement courses are offered in 2D Art and Design, Biology, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Chemistry, Chinese, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principles, English Language, English Literature and Composition, European History, French, German, Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Physics, Psychology, Spanish, Statistics, U.S. Government & Politics and U.S. History. Honors opportunities are available in Algebra 2, Biology, Chamber Orchestra, Chemistry, Choir 400, English 9 and 10, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, Science 9, Wind Ensemble, and World Studies.

*** AP courses are graded on a 5.0 scale. * Honors Courses are graded on a 4.5 scale.**

College Credit Plus

The state sponsored dual enrollment option is available to all students who meet the requirements of respective post secondary institutions. The 3 digit code after course name represents the college/university where the specific course was taken.
