I, _____, hereby state as follows, based on my personal knowledge:

I have initiated legal proceedings for the custody of : _____, birth date: _____.

I understand that Ohio Revised Code 3313.64(E) permits me to enroll the above named child into the Hilliard City School District (my district of residence) for **up to sixty (60) school days**, tuition free.* Per the district's requirement, attached is a copy of the time-stamped court document indicating that I have initiated legal proceedings for custody of this child.

Within sixty (60) school days, I will provide the Records Compliance Office with a copy of the signed, certified court order granting legal custody to me.

If custody has not been granted within sixty (60) school days from the child's first day of attendance, I agree to immediately enter into a tuition agreement with the Hilliard City School District and pay tuition at a rate of \$ 56.32 per day until custody is granted to me by the courts. Tuition is due and collected in full on the first day of each month. If tuition is not paid as agreed, or if I do not establish a tuition agreement with the district upon day sixty-one (61) of the child's first day of attendance, I understand that the above named child will be immediately withdrawn from the Hilliard City School District.
