School Safety

Last Friday we practiced our first fire drill and the kids did amazing! Everyone was out of the building within 4 minutes! This is exceptional for our first time doing a drill this year.

- Emergency Drill We have 3 scheduled emergency drills a year. Our first drill is Friday, September 7. We will conduct the fire drill for the month of September followed by a lockdown drill. A lock down drill means that not only are the school doors locked, but all classroom doors are locked as well. During this time, teachers share stories with the students about choices they can make for safety including when is it best to run, barricade, or fight if we have an unwanted visitor in the school. It's sad we have to do this these days, but it's our reality.
- **Parents in the Halls** I want to thank all parents who are abiding by our request to not walk the halls during the school day, especially in the morning. This has nothing to do with me or teachers pushing parents away. We LOVE seeing parents help. We do it for your child's safety. All teachers and scheduled visitors/volunteers wear badges identifying them in the halls. Students and staff should never experience seeing an adult in the hall unidentified. This is where safety steps in. If there's a person in the hall that is not on staff this is alarming, even if you think everyone knows you they don't. Again, it's sad that we have come to this situation in our society.

We love having visitors in Ridgewood. I enjoy seeing parents supporting teachers and helping out in classrooms! If you are interested in doing this, contact your child's teacher and schedule time to come in and help. Once scheduled, you will need to sign in the office and wear a visitor's badge, and that's it!
