School Community Meeting - "Press Pause"

This month we are working on "Pressing Pause." We discussed *Staying Above the Line* and *No BCD*. Ask your child what BCD stands for! (Blaming, Complaining, Defending). I explained that defending is like making up excuses. Two videos were used for our students to identify examples of pressing pause and staying above the line. Fire Drill and First Emergency Practice Drill

We conducted two drills on Friday. We did our first Emergency Drill. It was a level one which means the teachers lock their doors and instruction continues.
