SACC Pandemic Response Protocols



SACC will conduct daily temperature checks and health assessments of staff & Students

A temperature screening station will be at the entrance to each SACC program. A member of our team will take your child's temperature, do a quick health assessment and ask your child to wash his/her hands. Children with a temp of 100 degrees or higher or showing any signs of illness will be sent home immediately.



SACC will require all staff & students to wear face coverings.

We will follow HCSD face covering protocol. Please provide your child with his/her own face covering.



SACC will follow ODE guidelines on maintaining proper handwashing

Students and staff will wash thier hands before entering the program & when they leave for the day. Hand sanitizer will be available at all times. General frequency of handwashing will increase.



SACC will clean, disinfect & sanitize more frequently

We will follow all ODE requirements. Great care will be made to ensure that all high touch surfaces, games and equiptment are thoroughly cleaned in between use.



Changes to our drop-off/pickup procedures

At drop-off we ask that only one parent (ideally the same one every time) brings their child to SACC. Parents must remain outside the building & wait until staff have completed the temperature check and health assessment. Staff will then sign the student into the program. At pickup we ask that you stop at the door and we will call for your student. Students will wash their hands before they leave and staff will sign them out of the program. If parents need to communicate with the Site Coordinator please call, email or schedule an in person meeting.



Assigned Cohort System

SACC will operate with smaller group sizes within your child's SACC space. We will place children in small groups or "cohorts". Groups will not mix until the infection alert is over. Social distancing measures will be implemented within the cohort. Staff will not rotate between groups during a SACC session. Sharing toys ect. will not be permitted.
