ISPTO Update

- ISPTO will not raise annual membership fees
- Fundraising topics
 - Flower sales across district were down in SY 2018-19 (all Hilliard Schools used Fortmeyer as vendor)
 - Requested list of all spirit night partner businesses to share amongst district
 - Fundraising incentive ideas shared (e.g., principal duct taped to the wall)
 - Why do PTOs fund the things they do?; what can we do to raise more?;
 somethings may not be able to be funded moving forward
 - Grants available (e.g., author visits)
 - Considering new ISPTO FB page to share ideas/info/opportunities
 - Sharing information at ISPTO meeting scored us a free popcorn popper!!

- HBOE and district conducting master facility plan: third party looking at facilities and programs which may include rezoning assignment (short timeline)
 - Sunday, 10/20/19 public invited to participate 6:00pm to 8:00pm (futures meeting)
